BERNAT Blanket Stitch Along

CLUE #5

INSTRUCTIONS

Sew long (side) edges of Strips from Weeks 1 and 2 tog, with single Week 2 Strip in center, using flat seam and taking care to match pat changes.



Tip: Align cast on and cast off edges of Strips at same side to ensure direction of pat is consistent.

First Joining Seam: With RS facing, A and first circular needle,

pick up and knit 96 sts (12 sts across each pat Block) across top edge of Week 1 and Week 2 Strips.

Next row: (WS). Knit.

Next row: Purl. Break yarn and leave sts on needle.

Tip: When picking up sts evenly across side edge of work, fold piece in half, place marker and then fold into quarters and place 2 more markers. Divide total st number by 4 and pick up sts evenly in each marked quarter section.

With RS facing, A and 2nd circular needle, pick up and knit 96 sts evenly across side edge of Slip St Tweed Section. Leave yarn attached. Having Weeks 1 and 2 Strips at top of work, align sts on first circular needle (Weeks 1 and 2 Strips) against sts on 2nd circular needle. Using 1 straight needle, (knit 1 st from each circular needle

tog) twice, then beg to cast off sts from both circular needles, at same time, joining Weeks 1 and 2 Strips to Slip St Tweed Section.

Second Joining Seam: With RS facing, A and first circular needle, pick up and knit 96 sts (12 sts across each pat Block) across bottom edge of Weeks 1 and 2 Strips.

Next row: (WS). Knit.

Next row: Purl. Break yarn and leave sts on needle.

With RS facing, A and 2nd circular needle, pick up and knit 96 sts evenly across side edge of Shaker Texture Section. Leave yarn attached.

Having Weeks 1 and 2 Strips at top of work, align sts on first circular needle (Weeks 1 and 2 Strips) against sts on 2nd circular needle. Using 1 straight needle, (knit 1 st from each circular needle

tog) twice, then beg to cast off sts from both circular needles, at same time, joining Weeks 1 and 2 Strips to Shaker Texture Section.
