chevron-banded
throw



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FINISHED SIZE: 60" x60"

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 60"x60" purchased throw
- 2½" Conso® chevron band trim, 7 yds ea: 2 colors
- Scissors
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Thread
- Iron & pressing surface

DIRECTIONS:

1. Line up the 2 chevron band trims side-by-side, with right sides up & long edges touching each other in the middle. One color will be on the left, the other on the right. Edges should touch, but not overlap.
2. Using a zigzag machine stitch, sew the trims together by stitching up the middle; the zigzag stitching will catch both edges, holding them securely in a flat seam. Stitch chevron band trims together for their entire length to create a single length of extra-wide trim to use as binding. Fold the chevron band trim binding along the seam, with wrong sides together. Bind the edges of the throw, placing the edge of the throw inside, touching the fold. Pin in place.
3. To miter corners, pin binding on the straight edge as close as possible to the corner, then turn binding at corner & pin along the next straight edge. Tuck the excess binding under at the corner as far as it will go to form a mitered corner. Pin in place.
4. Using a straight machine stitch, stitch the binding in place, stitching close to the loose edge of the binding & through all thicknesses. Catch the binding underneath to secure while sewing. Stop stitching at the corner, leaving the needle down. Pivot the throw & continue sewing along the next side. Remove pins.
5. Hand tack the folds of the mitered corners in place to secure. Press binding lightly for a smooth finish.
