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Sew with Jo-Ann

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/4 yd of 12 different cotton prints
- 2-1/2 yd of white for background, backing and binding
- 1-1/4 yd batting
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Iron & pressing surface

DIRECTIONS:

1/4" seam allowance used.

Enlarge pattern

CUTTING:

From each print, cut 3 triangles – total 36 triangles

From white cut: 30 triangles

12 half triangles – 6 left side, 6 right side

Two 24-1/2" x 48-1/2" for backing

Five 2" WOF strips for binding

From batting, cut one 48-1/2" x 48-1/2"

1. Using picture as guide, sew printed triangles to white triangles with a 1/4" seam into 6 rows of 6.
2. Sew half triangles to sides.
3. Press seams to dark side.
4. Sew rows together.
5. Press seams to dark side.
6. Sew center of backing, press seam open.
7. Sandwich batting between wrong sides of backing and front, matching centers and corners.
8. Pin and quilt as desired.
9. Sew binding strips together, press seams and fold in half lengthwise.
10. Trim edge of quilt if necessary and sew binding to right side of quilt.
11. Turn binding to back of quilt and slip stitch in place.
