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decoupage bangles



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SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- K&Company Super Paper Pad
- EK Success Herma Dotto Adhesive Tape Runner, Permanent
- EK Success Cutterpede Straight Edge Trimmer
- EK Success Cutter Bee Scissors
- Colorbok EM Metal Brad Accents
- ColorBox Ink Cats Eye Queue, Woodgrain
- Mod Podge Gloss, Luster
- Darice Designer Bangle Bracelet

DIRECTIONS:

CREAM BANGLE:

- 1. Cut paper into 5/8'' wide strips. Apply a generous amount of decoupage medium to a small part of the bangle and wrap paper strip around trimming end to overlap in the back. Apply decoupage medium to secure ends.
- 2. Repeat the process until entire bracelet is covered. Add a coat of decoupage medium to entire bracelet. Set aside to dry. When completely dry add metal accents.

BLUE BANGLE:

- 1. Tear paper into random pieces and ink edges with brown ink.
- 2. Apply a generous amount of decoupage medium and place torn pieces as desired, covering entire bracelet.
- 3. Finish with a coat of decoupage medium and set aside to dry.

STRIPED BANGLE:

- 1. Cut strips of cream and blue paper in various widths. Cut brown paper into thinner strips.
- 2. Adhere blue and cream pieces side by side with decoupage medium. Trim the ends of the strips to overlap on the back all the way around the bangle. Use the medium to add thin brown stripes to cover where the cream and black paper meet; overlap the brown strip in back and secure with decoupage medium.
- 3. Add coat of medium to entire bangle to finish and set aside to dry. When dry, add metal accents.
