

# sew with Jo-Ann



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## ARTISTIC ANNIE DOLL

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Red Heart® Super Saver® yarn, 1 skein each: Aran (A), Black (B), Orchid (C), Shocking Pink (D), Amethyst (E), Carrot (F), Medium Thyme (G)
- Crochet hook, size US G-6
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill
- 7" piece of heavy cardboard
- 4 small beads for earrings
- Heavy-duty sewing thread
- 1" button for bag
- Red crayon to shade cheeks
- Stitch marker
- Hairbrush

### DIRECTIONS:

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4"; 16 rows = 4" in single crochet. Be sure to check your gauge. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### SPECIAL STITCH:

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### NOTES:

1. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so fiberfill stuffing will not show between stitches.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

### HEAD AND BODY

Beginning at top of head, with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook — 6 sc. Do not join; work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around — 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 24 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—30 sc.

Rnds 8–15: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 16: [Sc2tog] 15 times—15 sts.

Rnds 17–19: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 20: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 7 times, sc in last sc—22 sc.

Rnd 21: [Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 2 times; change to B in last sc—24 sc.

Undershirt

Rnds 22–27: With B, sc in each sc around; change to A in last sc of Rnd 27.

Waist

Rnds 28 and 29: With A, sc in each sc around; change to B in last sc of Rnd 29.

Begin Knickers

Rnds 30–35: With B, sc in each sc around. Do not fasten off. Stuff body firmly.

Joining Row: Flatten lower edging, matching stitches. Working through both thicknesses, sc across to close lower edge.

Fasten off B.

ARM (make 2)

Beginning at top of arm, with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times—9 sc.

Rnds 3–19: Sc in each sc, stuffing arm as work progresses.

Rnd 20: [Sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc—6 sc.

Rnd 21: Work 2 sc in next 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc—9 sc.

Rnds 22–24: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 25: [Sc2tog] 4 times, sc in last sc—5 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff arm. Thread tail through stitches of last rnd and pull gently to close opening. Draw a strand of A through arm at elbow and pull to form elbow dimple. Sew arms to sides of body. With B, embroider a strap over each shoulder, from top front of undershirt to top back of undershirt.

EAR (make 2)

With A, ch 2.

Row 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew ears in place.

Earrings (make 2): Thread two beads onto heavy-duty sewing thread and sew to ear. Repeat for 2nd earring.

HAIR

Wrap F around 7" piece of heavy cardboard 150 times. Wrap E around same piece of cardboard 2 times. Cut one end of wraps. \*Fold one strand in half, forming a loop at folded end. Insert hook around a stitch on head of doll

at hairline. Place loop of folded strands on hook and draw through. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten; repeat from \* around hairline, placing the E-colored strands on top of head on right side. Continue to repeat from \* to fill in over back of head. Holding head firmly, brush hair with a hairbrush until desired texture is achieved. Trim ends to about shoulder length.

LEG (make 2)

Beginning at foot, with E, ch 6.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch—12 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc—18 sc.

Rnd 3: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around; change to A in last sc.

Rnd 4: With A, sc in next 6 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc—15 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc—12 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc—9 sc.

Rnds 7 and 8: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 9: Work 2 sc in first sc, sc in each remaining sc around—10 sc.

Rnds 10–27: Sc in each sc around, stuffing leg as work progresses; change to B in last sc.

Rnd 28: With B, sc in each sc around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Seam Toe: Flatten last row, matching stitches and ensuring that toe faces forward, sewing through both thicknesses, sew across.

Shoe Ties: With E, ch 50 for first tie, slip st in top of shoe at center back, ch 50 for 2nd tie. Fasten off. Crisscross ties around leg and tie in a bow at front.

Sew legs to bottom of body.

MOEBIUS SCARF

With C, ch 14.

Row 1: Work (sc, 2 dc) in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch 2, skip next 3 ch, (sc, 2 dc) in next ch; repeat from \* across, turn—4 (sc, 2 dc) groups.

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc, 2 dc) in first dc, \*ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, (sc, 2 dc) in next dc; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, skip next dc, dc in last sc, turn.

Repeat last row until piece is long enough to wrap very loosely around doll's shoulders. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Place piece flat then flip one short edge over. Sew short edges together.

HAT

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc.

Rnds 2 and 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each remaining st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 sc at the end of Rnd 3.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc] 11 times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 sc.

Rnds 5–7: Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

#### First Earflap

Note: Work now proceeds back and forth in rows.

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in next 7 dc, turn; leave remaining sts unworked—8 dc.

Row 9: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 4 times, turn—4 sc.

Row 11: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 2 times, turn—2 sc.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc2tog, ch 12 for tie. Fasten off.

#### Second Earflap

Row 8: Skip next 8 unworked dc following first earflap, join B with sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 7 dc, turn—8 dc.

Repeat Rows 9–12 of first earflap. Fasten off.

## DRESS

### Bodice

With D, ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—9 sc.

Rows 2–26: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across, turn. Do not turn at end of Row 26. Do not fasten off.

### Skirt

Row 1: Working in ends of rows across side of bodice, sc in end of each row across; change to E in last sc, turn—26 sc.

Row 2: With E, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in first sc (increase made), 2 dc in each remaining sc across, turn—52 dc.

Rows 3–7: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn; change to D in last st of Row 7.

Row 8 (Right Side): With D and working in front loops only, ch 3, dc in first dc (increase made), 2 dc in each remaining dc across, turn—104 dc.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in each dc across. Fasten off.

Row 10: Working in free back loops of Row 7, behind D-colored ruffle, join E with slip st in sc, ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in same sc (increase made), 2 tr in each remaining sc across, turn.

Row 11: Ch 3, dc in each tr across.

Fasten off. Sew back seam using matching yarn colors.

Neck Ties: With D, ch 35 for first tie, slip st in center top of bodice, ch 35 for 2nd tie. Fasten off.

## BAG

With B, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, \*dc in each of next 2 ch, sc in next 4 ch; repeat from \* across,

turn—16 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, \*dc in next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts; repeat from \* across; change to G in last st, turn. Do not fasten off B. Carry color not in use up side of piece until next needed.

Rows 3 and 4: With G, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next 3 sts, \*sc in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts; repeat from \* across, turn; change to B in last st of Row 4.

Rows 5 and 6: With B, work Row 2 twice; change to G in last sc of Row 6.

Rows 7–14: Repeat Rows 3–6 two times.

Rows 15–17: Repeat Rows 3–5.

Row 18: With B, ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next 2 sc, ch 4 for button loop, sc in next 2 sc, dc in next 2 dc, sc in last 4 sc. Fasten off.

Fold bag in half. Working through both thicknesses, join B with sc in one lower corner at fold, sc evenly spaced up side edge, ch 30 for strap; working through both thicknesses, sc down other side edge. Fasten off. Sew button opposite buttonhole.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Place clothing and accessories on doll.

### Embroider Face

With G, embroider satin stitch eyes. With F, embroider couched stitch eyebrows. With A, embroider satin stitch nose,

With D, embroider a couched stitch smile. With red crayon, gently rub color onto face for cheeks.

Bracelet: With D, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, hdc in next ch, sc in last 2 ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Wrap bracelet around wrist of doll and sew ends together.

Weave in ends.

Finished size doll measures 16" tall

## LOVELY LUCY DOLL

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Red Heart® Super Saver® yarn, 1 skein each: Aran (A), Petal Pink (B), Pale Plum (C), Monet (D), Cafe (E), Commel (F), Orchid (G), small amount each of Delft Blue (H) & Shocking Pink (I) to embroider face
- Crochet hook, size US G-6
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill stuffing
- 8" piece of heavy cardboard
- 2" piece of heavy cardboard
- Small pearl beads for earrings and necklace
- Heavy-duty sewing thread

- Elastic band for ponytail
- 1" white button
- Red crayon to shade cheeks

## DIRECTIONS:

**GUAGE:** 20 sts = 4"; 16 rows = 4" in single crochet. Be sure to check your gauge. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## SPECIAL STITCH:

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## NOTES:

1. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so fiberfill stuffing will not show between stitches.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

## HEAD AND BODY

Beginning at top of head, with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook — 6 sc. Do not join; work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around — 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 24 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 30 sc.

Rnds 8–15: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 16: [Sc2tog] 15 times — 15 sts.

Rnds 17–19: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 20: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 7 times, sc in last sc — 22 sc.

Rnd 21: [Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 2 times; change to B in last sc — 24 sc.

Undershirt

Rnds 22–27: With B, sc in each sc around; change to A in last sc of Rnd 27.

Waist

Rnds 28 and 29: With A, sc in each sc around; change to B in last sc of Rnd 29.

Begin Knickers

Rnds 30–35: With B, sc in each sc around. Do not fasten off. Stuff body firmly.

Joining Row: Flatten lower edging, matching stitches. Working through both thicknesses, sc across to close lower edge.

Fasten off B.

ARM (make 2)

Beginning at top of arm, with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook — 6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times — 9 sc.

Rnds 3–19: Sc in each sc, stuffing arm as work progresses.

Rnd 20: [Sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc — 6 sc.

Rnd 21: Work 2 sc in next 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc — 9 sc.

Rnds 22–24: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 25: [Sc2tog] 4 times, sc in last sc — 5 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff arm. Thread tail through stitches of last rnd and pull gently to close opening. Draw a strand of A through arm at elbow and pull to form elbow dimple. Sew arms to sides of body. With B, embroider a strap over each shoulder, from top front of undershirt to top back of undershirt.

EAR (make 2)

With A, ch 2.

Row 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew ears in place.

Earrings: With heavy-duty sewing thread, sew one pearl bead on each ear.

## HAIR

Ponytail: Wrap F around 8" piece of heavy cardboard 120 times. Cut one end of wraps. \*Hold two strands together and fold in half, forming a loop at folded end. Insert hook around a stitch on head of doll at hairline. Place loop of folded strands on hook and draw through. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten; repeat from \* around hairline, then continue to repeat from \* to fill in over back of head. Draw hair neatly to middle of back of head to form a ponytail. Secure ponytail with elastic band.

Bangs: Wrap F around 2" piece of heavy cardboard 20 times. Cut one end of wraps. Attach strands across forehead hairline in same manner as ponytail strands.

Trim ends of ponytail and bangs to make even.

Bow: With C, ch 80. Fasten off. Tie bow around ponytail.

LEG (make 2)

Beginning at foot, with E, ch 6.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch — 12 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc — 18 sc.

Rnd 3: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: Sc in next 6 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc — 15 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc — 12 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc — 9 sc.

Rnds 7 and 8: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 9: Work 2 sc in first sc, sc in each remaining sc around — 10 sc.

Rnds 10–15: Sc in each sc around, stuffing leg as you go; change to A in last sc.

Rnds 16–27: With A, sc in each sc around; change to B in last sc of Round 27.

Rnd 28: With B, sc in each sc around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Seam Toe: Flatten last row, matching stitches and ensuring that toe faces forward, sewing through both thicknesses, sew across.

Top of Boots (make 1 for each leg): With E, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across. Fasten off. Sew around top of boot.

Sew legs to bottom of body.

## SKIRT

With D, ch 17. Note: Skirt is worked side to side.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 4 ch, hdc in next 5 ch, dc in last 6 ch, turn — 16 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 5 dc, hdc in next 5 hdc, sc in last 5 sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, hdc in next 5 hdc, dc in last 6 dc, turn.

Rows 4–27: Repeat last 2 rows 12 times.

Row 28: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 5 dc, hdc in next 5 hdc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 1, skip next sc, sc in last sc — buttonhole made.

Fasten off. Sew back seam from lower edge to first sc; leave top part unsewn. Sew button opposite buttonhole.

## TOP

Beginning at lower edge, with C, ch 31.

Row 1: Work sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each remaining ch across, turn — 30 sc.

Rows 2–7: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, ch 10 for first strap, skip next 6 sc, sc in next 10 sc, ch 10 for 2nd strap, skip next 6 sc, sc in last 4 sc, turn — 18 sc and 2 ch-10 spaces.

Row 9: Ch 1, slip st in first 4 sc, sc in next 10 ch, slip st in next 10 sc, sc in next 10 ch, slip st in last 4 sc — 30 sc and 8 slip sts. Fasten off.

## SWEATER

With G, ch 35.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn — 34 sc.

Rows 2–10: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Right Front

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc; leave remaining sts unworked for armholes, back and left front; turn — 6 sc.

Rows 12–17: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Back

Row 11: Skip next 5 unworked sc following right front, join G with sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc; leave remaining sts unworked for armhole and left front — 12 sc.

Rows 12–17: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Left Front

Row 11: Skip next 5 unworked sc following back, join G with sc in next sc, sc in each remaining sc across — 6 sc.

Rows 12–17: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Shoulder Seam: Fold fronts over back. Beginning at side edge, sew two stitches together across each top edge for shoulder seams. Fold back unsewn front portions for collar.

Sleeve

Row 1: Join G with sc in center unworked sc at one underarm, work 20 more sc evenly spaced around armhole; do not join; turn — 21 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog, turn — 18 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, sc2tog, sc in last 8 sc, turn — 17 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, sc2tog, sc in last 8 sc, turn — 16 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, sc2tog, sc in last 7 sc, turn — 15 sc.

Rows 9 and 10: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn — 12 sc.

Rows 12–16: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew sleeve seam. Repeat for 2nd sleeve.

## POCKETBOOK

With E, ch 6.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch, working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch — 12 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc — 18 sc.

Rnd 3: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 24 sc.

Rnds 5–9: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 10: Sc in next 4 sc, ch 10 for first handle, skip next 4 sc, sc in next 8 sc, ch 10 for 2nd handle, skip next 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc — 16 sc and 2 ch-10 spaces.

Rnd 11: Sc in each sc and ch around.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Place clothing and accessories on doll.

Embroider Face

With H, embroider satin stitch eyes. With E, embroider couched stitch eyebrows. With A, embroider satin stitch nose,  
With I, embroider a couched stitch smile. With red crayon, gently rub color onto face for cheeks.

Necklace: Thread pearls onto heavy-duty sewing thread. Wrap beads around neck, then tie ends of thread together and trim.

Finished size doll measures 16" tall

## FASHIONISTA FARRAH DOLL

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Red Heart® Super Saver® yarn, 1 skein each: Buff (A), Soft White (B), Shocking Pink (C), Blue Tones (D), Black (E), Coffee (F), Pink Camo (G)
- Crochet hook, size US G-6
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Various small beads for earrings and bracelet
- Heavy-duty sewing thread
- Button for pocketbook
- Red crayon to shade cheeks

### DIRECTIONS:

**GUAGE:** 20 sts = 4"; 16 rows = 4" in single crochet. Be sure to check your gauge. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### SPECIAL STITCH:

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### NOTES:

1. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so fiberfill stuffing will not show between stitches.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

## HEAD AND BODY

Beginning at top of head, with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook — 6 sc. Do not join; work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around — 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 24 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times — 30 sc.

Rnds 8–15: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 16: [Sc2tog] 15 times — 15 sts.

Rnds 17–19: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 20: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 7 times, sc in last sc — 22 sc.

Rnd 21: [Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 2 times; change to B in last sc — 24 sc.

Undershirt

Rnds 22–27: With B, sc in each sc around; change to A in last sc of Rnd 27.

Waist

Rnds 28 and 29: With A, sc in each sc around; change to B in last sc of Rnd 29.

Begin Knickers

Rnds 30–35: With B, sc in each sc around. Do not fasten off. Stuff body firmly.

Joining Row: Flatten lower edging, matching stitches. Working through both thicknesses, sc across to close lower edge.  
Fasten off B.

ARM (make 2)

Beginning at top of arm, with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook — 6 sc. Do not join; work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times — 9 sc.

Rnds 3–19: Sc in each sc, stuffing arm as work progresses.

Rnd 20: [Sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc — 6 sc.

Rnd 21: Work 2 sc in next 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc — 9 sc.

Rnds 22–24: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 25: [Sc2tog] 4 times, sc in last sc — 5 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff arm. Thread tail through stitches of last rnd and pull gently to close opening. Draw a strand of A through arm at elbow and pull to form elbow dimple. Sew arms to sides of body. With B, embroider a strap over each shoulder, from top front of undershirt to top back of undershirt.

## HAIR

### Long Strip (make 7)

Row 1: With F, \*ch 23, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and each remaining ch across; repeat from \* 9 more times. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew first strip, centered on back of head, across Rnd 13—each side should end at hairline. [Sew next strip, centered on back of head, across next row above previous strip] 6 times.

### Medium Strip (make 3)

Row 1: With F, \*ch 23, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and each remaining ch across; repeat from \* 7 more times. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew first strip, centered on back of head, across next row above last long strip. [Sew next strip, centered on back of head, across next row above previous strip] 2 times.

### Small Strip (make 3)

Row 1: With F, \*ch 23, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and each remaining ch across; repeat from \* 5 more times. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew first strip, centered on back of head, across next row above last medium strip. [Sew next strip, centered on back of head, across next row above previous strip] 2 times. Note: The last strip should be at center top of head.

## EAR (make 2)

With A, ch 2.

Row 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew ears in place.

Earrings (make 2): Thread three beads onto heavy-duty sewing thread and sew to ear. Repeat for 2nd earring.

## LEG (make 2)

Beginning at foot, with E, ch 6.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch—12 sc. Do not join; work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc—18 sc.

Rnd 3: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around; change to A in last sc.

Rnd 4: With A, sc in next 6 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc—15 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc—12 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc—9 sc.

Rnds 7 and 8: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 9: Work 2 sc in first sc, sc in each remaining sc around—10 sc.

Rnds 10–27: Sc in each sc around, stuffing leg as work progresses; change to B in last sc.

Rnd 28: With B, sc in each sc around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Seam Toe: Flatten last row, matching stitches and ensuring that toe faces forward, sewing through both thicknesses, sew across.

Sew legs to bottom of body.

## JEANS (make 2)

Beginning at waist, with D, ch 14.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—13 sc.

Rows 2–6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 6 sc, turn—14 sc.

First Leg

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, turn; leave remaining sts unworked for 2nd leg—7 sc.

Rows 9–24: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off.

Second Leg

Row 8: Join D with sc in first unworked sc following Row 8 of first leg, sc in remaining 6 unworked sc, turn—7 sc.

Rows 9–24: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off. Sew side seams and inner leg seams.

## APRON

Beginning at neck edge, with G, ch 16.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in each remaining ch across, turn—30 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, [sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times, turn—36 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 6 sc, sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in each of next 6 sc, sc in last 6 sc, turn—48 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in next 6 sc, ch 3, skip next 12 sc for underarm, sc in next 12 sc, ch 3, skip next 12 sc for underarm, sc in last 6 sc, turn—24 sc and 2 ch-3 spaces.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc and ch across, turn—30 sc.

Rows 6–11: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 12: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip first sc, dc in next sc, \*ch 1, dc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—30 dc and 29 ch-1 spaces.

Row 13: Ch 1, sc in each dc and ch across, turn—59 sc.

Row 14: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip first 2 sc, dc in next sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—30 dc and 29 ch-1 spaces.

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each dc and ch across, turn—59 sc.

Rows 16–18: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rows 19–22: Repeat Rows 14 and 15 twice.

Fasten off.

Neck Ties

With G, ch 35 for first tie, join with slip st in top corner of apron, slip st in each ch across opposite side of apron foundation ch, ch 35 for 2nd tie. Fasten off.

Waist Ties

Join G with slip st on one side of apron at waist (Row 11), ch 35. Fasten off. Repeat on other side of waist.

FLOWER/HAT

With D, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook — 6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Working in front loops only, (slip st, ch 1, sc) in first st (petal made), \*ch 1, (slip st, ch 1, sc) in next st; repeat from \* around — 6 petals.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, working behind petals into free back loops of Rnd 1, (slip st, ch 2, dc) in first sc, \*ch 2, (slip st, ch 2, dc) in next sc; repeat from \* around; slip st in first sc again. Fasten off. Sew flower/hat to top of head.

## BAG

With C, ch 12.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 9 ch, 3 sc in last ch, working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 9 ch, 2 sc in last ch — 24 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rnds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc — 30 sc.

Rnds 3–11: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 12: [Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 6 times — 24 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 3 sc, ch 35 for strap, skip next 10 sc, slip st in next 2 sc, turn; leave remaining sts unworked.

Strap: Ch 1, sc in each of the 35 ch, slip st in next sc; leave remaining sts unworked. Fasten off.

## Flower

With C, ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 12 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Working in front loops only, ch 1, 2 sc in same st as join, 2 sc in each remaining sc around; join with slip st in first sc — 24 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, working behind sts of Rnd 2 and into free back loops of Rnd 1, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each remaining st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off. Sew flower to front of bag. Sew button to center of flower.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Place clothing and accessories on doll.

### Embroider Face

With F, embroider satin stitch eyes and couched stitch eyebrows. With A, embroider satin stitch nose. With C, embroider a couched stitch smile. With red crayon, gently rub color onto face for cheeks.

Bracelet: Use any style and number of beads desired, sufficient to encircle wrist of doll. Thread beads onto heavy-duty sewing thread. Wrap beads around wrist, then tie ends of thread together and trim.

Finished size doll measures 16" tall
