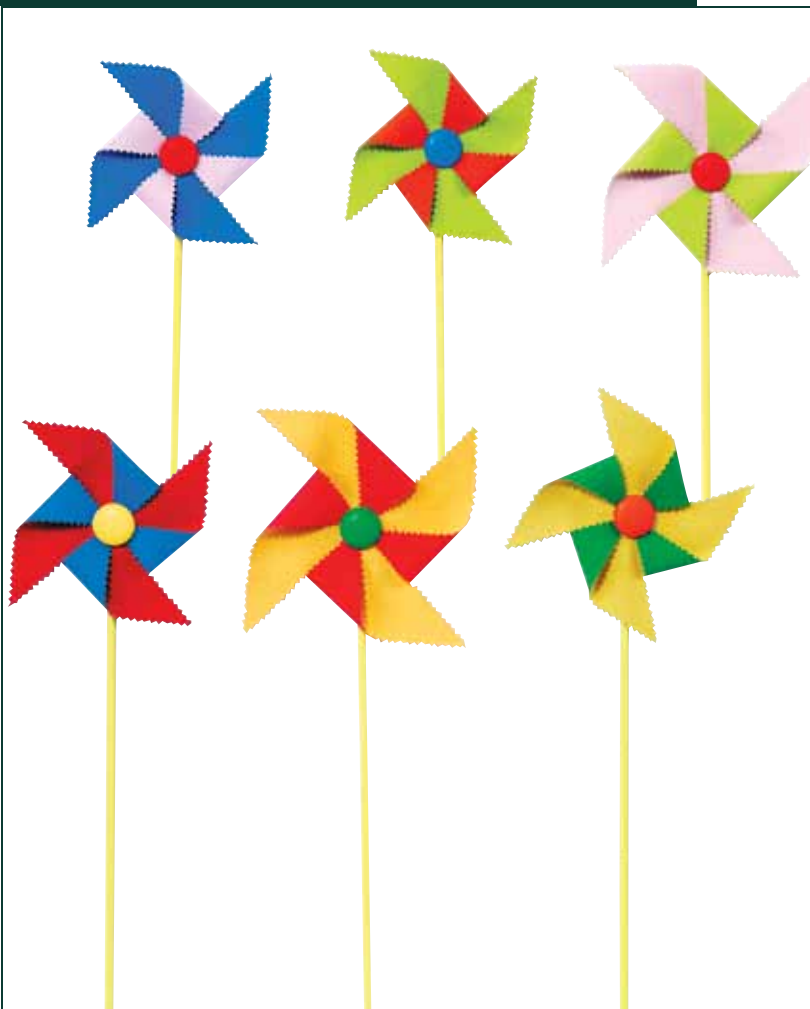


fabric pinwheels

Craft with Jo-Ann

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 6" square of 2 contrasting fabrics
- 6" square of fusible webbing, Heat-n-Bond
- Disappearing fabric marker
- Pinking shears or pinking rotary cutter
- 7/8" cover button
- 18"-long 1/2"-diam. dowel rod
- Matching paint
- Paint brush
- Glue

DIRECTIONS:

1. Fuse wrong side of contrasting fabrics together following manufacturer's directions.
2. Draw a 5" square onto one side with disappearing fabric marker.
3. Cut out square with pinking shears or rotary cutter.
4. Cut down corners as indicated on pattern.
5. Cover button following manufacturer's directions.
6. Place a small amount of glue in center of square and bring corners to center to form pinwheel.
7. Glue button over center.
8. Paint dowel rod, allow to dry and glue pinwheel to dowel rod.

Note: pinwheels can be made in any size, by using different size squares.
