SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Cuttlebug[®] embossing machine
- Cuttlebug[®] embossing folder: Brocade Border
- Leather snaps
- Leather
- Craft knife
- Acrylic paint
- StazOn[®] stamp pad
- Leather punch
- Tape measure

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut strips of leather 1" wide. Emboss them with Cuttlebug[®] Brocade Border embossing folder.
2. Paint with acrylic paint. Get the paint into crevices in a thin, even layer. Allow to dry.
3. Carefully stamp top of leather with stamp pad to color only in the raised design. Allow to dry.
4. Measure circumference of wrist plus extra overlap for snaps.
5. Punch holes in ends of leather in size for snaps. Attach snaps, following package instructions.
