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## Craft with Jo-Ann

#### CROCHETED CANDY APRON

Finished size 25"x18", excluding ties.

#### **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- Bernat® Handicrafter® Cotton Yarns: 1 skein ea Liquorice Treat Twist (MC), Cotton Candy (A)
- Size I/9 crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Basic sewing supplies

Gauge: 12 sc and 13 rows = 4''

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

APRON: Beg at bottom, with MC, ch 74.

Row 1: (RS). 1 sc in second ch from hook. \*Ch 1. Miss next 3 ch. (1 dc. Ch 1. Dc2tog. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1) in next ch. Miss next 3 ch. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next ch. Rep from \* 7 times more. Ch 1. Miss next 3 ch. (1 dc. Ch 1. Dc2tog. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1) in next ch. Miss next 3 ch. 1 sc in last ch. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 4. 1 dc in first sc (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc). Ch 1. Miss next 3 sts. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next st. \*Ch 1. Miss next 4 sts. (1 dc. Ch 1. Dc2tog. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1) in next ch-3 sp. Miss next 4 sts. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next st.

Rep from  $\star$  7 times more. Ch 1. Miss next 3 sts. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in last sc. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Ch 1. Miss next 4 sts. (1 dc. Ch 1. Dc2tog. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1) in next ch-3 sp. Miss next 4 sts. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next st.

Rep from \* 7 times more. Ch 1. Miss next 4 sts. (1 dc. Ch 1. Dc2tog. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1) in next ch-3 sp. Miss next 3 sts. 1 sc in third ch in beg ch 4. Turn. Rep second and third rows until work from beg measures 15", ending with a second row.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. Ch 3. Miss next 4 sts. \*1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. Miss next 4 sts. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. Miss next 4 sts.

Rep from \* 7 times more. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. Miss next 3 sts. 1 sc in third ch of beg ch 4. Fasten off. EDGING/WAISTBAND/TIES: With A, ch 50. With RS facing, join with sl st at top right corner of Apron.

Rnd 1: Ch 1. Work down side of apron, work 2 sc in side of each dc & 1 sc in side of each sc to corner st. Work 3 sc in corner st. Work 72 sc evenly across bottom edge to corner. Work 3 sc in corner st. Work up side of apron, work 2 sc in side of each dc & 1 sc in side of each sc to corner st. Ch 51. 1 sc in second ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 49 ch. Work 72 sc evenly across top edge to corner st. 1 sc in each of next 50 ch. Turn.

Beg working in rows: Row 1: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 172 sc. Turn. Rep last row 5 times more. Fasten off.

CANDY POCKETS: Make 2. Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as st. With A, ch 3. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2. 8 hdc in ring. Join with sl st to first hdc. Rnd 2: Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc to end of round. Join with sl st to first hdc. 16 hdc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first hdc. 24 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2. (1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first hdc. 32 hdc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first hdc. 40 hdc.

Rnd 6: Ch 2. (1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first hdc. 48 hdc. Do not fasten off.

Beg working in rows: first candy end:

Row 1: \*\*Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Rows 2-4: Ch 2. 2 hdc in first hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to last hdc. 2 hdc in last hdc. Turn. Fasten off

after last row.\*\*

Second candy end: Miss next 18 unworked hdc. Join A with sl st to next hdc. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for first candy end.

CANDY TIES: Make 4. With MC, ch 55. Fasten off. Sew pockets to apron. Tie candy ties around candy ends.



### CROCHETED CANDY STORE LILY SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Bernat<sup>®</sup> Handicrafter<sup>®</sup> Cotton Yarns, 1 skein ea: Marshmallow (MC), Blue Snow Cone (A), Red Liquorice(B), Lemon Drop (C), Lime Burst (D), Spicy Twists (E)
- Crochet hooks: E/4 & H/8 or size to obtain gauge
- Stuffing, tissue paper, tape, stitch markers
- Sewing machine & basic sewing supplies
- Brown pipe cleaner, small button
- 2 small black beads
- Embroidery floss: black, red

Gauge: Doll: 16 sc & 20 rows = 4"

Dress: 13 sc & 14 rows = 4"

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

HEAD: With MC and smaller hook, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 8 sc in second ch from hook.

Join with sl st to first sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around.

Join with sl st to first sc to join 16 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 32 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 40 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around.

Join with sl st to first sc. Rep last rnd 10 times more. Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from \* ground. Join with sl st to first sc. 32 sts.

Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from  $\star$  around.

Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sts. Stuff head.

Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 16 sts.

Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2toa.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first st. 8 sts.
Stuff rem of Head Fasten off

BODY: With MC and smaller hook, ch 30.

Join with sl st to first ch, taking care not to twist ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around.

Rnd 2: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around.

Join with sl st to first sc.

Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 2".

Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2toq. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc.

Rep from  $\star$  around. Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sts. Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 4".

Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 18 sts. Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rep last rnd twice more. Fasten off.

Sew bottom edge of body closed. Stuff body.

ARMS: Make 2. With MC, ch 2. Rnd 1: 5 sc in second ch from hook. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. 10 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 1 tr in next sc (thumb). 1 sc in each of last 5 sc.

Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around.

Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc) twice. Join with sl st to first sc. 8 sts.

Rnd 7: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around.

Join with sl st to first sc.

Rep last rnd until arm from beg measures 4".
Fasten off. Stuff arms.

LEGS: Make 2.

Shoes: With A and smaller hook, ch 5.

Rnd 1: 1 sc in second ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. 3 sc in last ch. Do not turn. Working in rem loops of foundation ch, 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. 2 sc in last ch. Join with sl st to first sc. 10 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in each of next 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in each of last 2 sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 16 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in each of next 4 sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in each of next 3 sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sc. Rnd 4: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. (Sc2tog) 3 times. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join MC with sl st to first sc. Place marker at end of rnd. 21 sts.

Rnd 6: With MC, ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. (Sc2tog) 3 times. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join with sl st to first sc. 17 sts. Rnd 7: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. (Sc2tog) 3 times. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first sc. 14 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. Rep last rnd until leg from top of shoe measures 5". Fasten off.

Shoe straps: Join A with sl st to 6th sc of marked rnd. Ch 5. Join with sl st to 13th sc of marked rnd. Fasten off. Stuff legs. Sew top of legs closed. Sew to bottom of body. Attach arms to sides of body.

HAIR FRINGE: Cut 11" of tape. Secure to a flat surface with sticky side up. Cut 14" lengths of A. Center them across the tape. Hold tissue paper over top of yarn. Using sewing machine, run a line of stitching along length of tape. Remove tape when hair is secure. Remove tissue paper. Pin fringe to outside of head. Backstitch hair into place along sewn line. Fold hair up. Secure at top of head.

FACE: Embroider mouth with red floss & eyelashes with black. Attach bead eyes. Sew head to body. DRESS: Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as hdc. With B and larger hook, ch 28. Join with sl st to first ch

With B and larger hook, ch 28. Join with sl st to first cl to form ring, taking care not to twist ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join with sl st to first sc. 28 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in same sp as last sl

st. 2 dc in each sc around.

Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 56 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each dc around. Join C with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rnd 4: With C, ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st.

1 hdc in each of next 2 dc. (Yoh and draw up a loop.

Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times in
next dc. Yoh and draw through 5 loops on hook —
bobble made. \*1 hdc in each of next 3 dc. Bobble.

Rep from \* around. Join B with sl st to first hdc.

Rnd 5: With B, ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st.

1 hdc in next st. Hdc2tog. \*1 hdc in each of next

2 sts. Hdc2tog. Rep from \* around.

Join D with sl st to first hdc. 42 sts.

Rnd 6: With D, ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in next st. Bobble. \*1 hdc in each of next 2 sts.

Bobble. Rep from \* around.

Join B with sl st to first hdc.

Rnd 7: With B, ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. Hdc2tog. \*1 hdc in next st. Hdc2tog.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 28 sts. Rnd 8: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st around.

Join C with sl st to first hdc.

Rnd 9: With C, ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. Hdc2tog. \*1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. Hdc2tog. Rep from \* around.

Join B with sl st to first hdc. 24 sts.

Rnd 10: With B, ch 2. 1 hdc in each st around. Join with sl st to first hdc.

Beg working in rows for back opening:

Row 1: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Do not join. Turn. Rep last row 2X.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Ch 4. Join with sl st to last hdc (button loop made). Fasten off.

STRAPS: Make 2. With B & larger hook, ch 6. Fasten off. Try on dress. Attach each strap at top edge. Sew button to correspond with button loop.

LOLLIPOP: Make 2.

Use larger hook & E, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook. SI st to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around.

SI st to first sc. 12 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1. \*1 sc in first sc. 2 sc in next sc.

Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 18 sc.

Fasten off.

Join WS of both pieces tog, join E to any sc.
Work through both thicknesses, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc
around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
Cut 3" pipe cleaner. Fold in half & twist tog.
Insert into lollipop. Tack to doll's hand.

# KNITTED PLACEMATS & NAPKIN RINGS SUPPLIES & TOOLS: Makes two 18"x13" placemats or eight 4" napkin rings.

- Bernat<sup>®</sup> Handicrafter<sup>®</sup> Cotton Yarns: Squishy Twist (A), Marshmellow (B), Blue Snow Cone (C), Grape Squirt (D), Squishy Twist (E)
- Size 7 knitting needles
- Size 7 double-pointed knitting needles or size to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 20 sts and 26 rows = 4'' in stocking st.

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

PLACEMATS: Make 4.

STRIPE PAT: With A, work 8 rows.

With B, work 2 rows. With A, work 2 rows.

With C, work 10 rows. \*With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows. With A, work 2 rows.

With D, work 10 rows. With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 10 rows. With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows. With A, work 2 rows.

With C, work 10 rows. Rep from \* once more.

With B, work 2 rows. With A, work 8 rows

These 120 rows complete Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 73 sts.

Row 1: (WS). Knit.

Row 2: K1. ssk. \*K5. M1. K1. M1. K5. Sl2tog. K1. p2sso. Rep from \* 3 times more. K5. M1. K1. M1. K5. K2tog. K1.

Row 3: K1. P1. \*K6. P1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

Last 2 rows form Zigzag Pat.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cont in Zigzag Pat until 120 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Cast off.

NAPKIN RINGS: Make 4.

CANDY: With E, cast on 6 sts. Knit 5 rows (garter st).

Row 1: (WS) K2tog. K2. K2tog. 4 sts.Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: (K2tog) twice. 2 sts.Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K1. M1. K1. 3 sts.

Row 6: (K1. M1) twice. K1. 5 sts. Row 7: Knit.

Rows 8 & 9: K1. M1. Knit to last 2 sts. M1. K1. Row 10: Knit.

Row 11: As Row 8, 11 sts. Rows 12-17: Knit.

Row 18: K1. K2tog. K5. K2tog. K1. 9 sts. Row 19: Knit.

Row 20: K1. K2tog. K3. K2tog. K1. 7 sts. Row 21: Knit.

Row 22: (K1. K2tog) twice. K1. 5 sts.

Row 23: K2tog. K1. K2tog. 3 sts.

Row 24: K1. K2tog. 2 sts. Row 25: Knit.

Row 26: (Incl in next st) twice. 4 sts.

Row 27: K1 M1 K2 M1 K1 6 sts

Rows 28-32: Knit. Cast off. Weave in ends.

Candy ends will twist naturally.

I-CORD: Make 4.

With pair of double-pointed needles & D, cast on 3 sts.

Next row: K3. Do not turn. \*Slide sts to other end of needle. K4. Rep from \* until cord measures 5".

Cast off, leaving a long end.

Thread yarn end onto tapestry needle. Sew ends of i-cord tog to form ring. Attach to back of candy.
