Craft with Jo-Ann

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2 pine garlands with berries, greenery & pine cones
- 4 green eucalyptus bushes with glittered edges
- 3 red/gold leaf bushes
- Hot glue gun & glue sticks
- 1-3 pkgs Wired Accents gold wire
- Wire cutters
- Wallet-size black & white family photos
- Needle-nose pliers

DIRECTIONS:

 Refer to diagram.

1. Attach garlands together. Design tip: Shape pine out from center; arrange branches to the left and right.
2. Trim eucalyptus from bushes. Push petals slightly closer together and trim stem again. Glue pieces into garland left and right of center. Design tip: Place more eucalyptus in center and less moving toward the ends.
3. Repeat step 2 with leaf bushes. Trim and glue in place.
4. For each photo frame, cut a 24" length of Wired Accents gold wire. Bend wire in half and wrap each segment once around finger. Curl top edge of each wire as loosely or tightly as desired. Insert photos.
5. Cut a 3"-4" length of wire and bend into an S-hook for hanging photo frames.
