craft with Jo-ann.







- Offray® ribbon Needle & thread Cloth-covered wire Flip-flops Scissors
- Spring clothespins Fabric glue Tape measure

GERBER DAISY FLIP-FLOPS SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2 large gerbera daisies
- 21/4 yds ribbon: 11/2"-wide, black & white polka dot
- 21/4 yds grosgrain ribbon: 7/8"-wide, in black, fuchsia & white stripe

DIRECTIONS:

Cut 3/4 yard from stripe ribbon. Center ribbon around toe; pull ends out from front of flip-flop. Bring ribbon up & over strap. Wrap each side of strap. Secure ends with glue. Make a bow using half the length of the wider ribbon. Make 6 loops without tails. Wire bow at center & glue to toe. Cut a 13" length of stripe ribbon. Roll in a circle, overlapping ends 1/2". Close circle; pinch at center to create 2-loop bow. Wire bow to center. Glue bow to center of large bow. Glue gerbera daisy to center of bows. Repeat for the other flip-flop.

RAINBOW FLIP-FLOPS SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

• Grosgrain ribbon, 2¾ yds each: Choose 5

DIRECTIONS:

Cut ribbon into 7" lengths, cut ends at an angle. Divide ribbon lengths into two equal piles. Alternating ribbon colors, center each ribbon strip on strap & tie together, then knot. Knot again. Repeat until all ribbon lengths from one pile is used. Repeat for the other flip-flop.

CONFETTI/STRIPE FLIP-FLOP SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2% yds stripe grosgrain ribbon: 7/8"-wide
- 2 yds satin confetti dot ribbon: 7/8"-wide

DIRECTIONS:

Cut 1 yard of each ribbon. Glue ribbon side-by-side, overlapping 1/8". Glue outside edges over 1/2". Allow to dry. Gather ribbon down center to cover strap. Secure ruffle with thread knots. Glue ruffle to outside strap. Use clothespins to hold ruffle in place while glue dries. Tie a shoestring bow with 14½" of stripe ribbon. Notch ribbon ends in an upside down V. Place a line of alue to seal ribbon ends. Glue bow to toe. Repeat for other flip-flop.
