

muslin snowmen

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/4 yd white muslin
- 1" x 12" fabric scraps for scarves
- Polyester stuffing
- Disappearing marker
- Scribbles® Fabric Paint – black, orange, red
- Pinking shears
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies

DIRECTIONS:

1. Enlarge patterns.
2. Fold muslin in half and lay patterns on top.
3. Use a disappearing marker to trace around patterns.
4. Cut muslin leaving at least 1/2" space around drawn pattern.
5. Use marking lines to sew around snowmen, leaving a small space open at the bottom for stuffing.
6. Use pinking shears to trim close to stitching.
7. Stuff snowmen.
8. Sew bottom opening closed.
9. Use disappearing marker to draw on faces and buttons.
10. Use black and orange fabric paint to paint on faces and buttons.
11. Use pinking shears to cut 1/2" x 10" piece of scarf fabric for snowman scarves.
12. Use red fabric paint to embellish scarves.
13. Allow fabric paint to dry thoroughly before tying on scarves.
