SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 7 pcs 3/8"x3"x24" basswood (makes 28 tiles)
- 1 pkg jute
- Martha Stewart Crafts™ acrylic paint: Gray Wolf, Porcelain Doll plus 6 colors of choice (for domino dots)
- Brushes: 1/2" flat, small flat
- Glue
- Saw
- Sandpaper or sanding belt
- White household candle
- Scissors
- X-Acto® knife
- Circle template
- Stylus or pencil
- Suitcase, optional

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut the basswood in 3"x6" blocks for 28 tiles. Round the corners with a sanding belt or sandpaper.
2. Paint all tiles with Gray Wolf paint and let dry.
3. Rub candle wax over the surfaces and edges of each tile, to create a wax-resist surface. Paint Porcelain Doll over the waxed tiles. Let dry.
4. When paint is dry, sand the tiles; the wax between the layers will allow the undercoat to become visible.
5. Wrap jute around the center of each tile, tie on the underneath surface; apply a drop of glue over the knot, then trim jute ends.
6. Using the stylus and circle template, impress the appropriate number of dots into ends of each tile. Paint inside the impressed circle. Sand lightly to remove some paint from the dots.
7. Optional: Use a decorative suitcase to store the dominos. Glue an envelope to the inside suitcase lid to hold game directions.
