SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Martha Stewart Crafts™ roving wool: 9 skeins Blue Agave, 3 skeins Jordan Almond
- Martha Stewart Crafts™ lofty wool blend: 4 skeins Snowdrift
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

DIRECTIONS:

Gauge: Not necessary with this project. Will vary with each person because size of fingers & hands. Keep crochet loose for a lovely open look.

1. Holding 2 strands of Blue Agave & 1 strand of Jordan Almond together, make slip stitch around four fingers. Using other hand as "hook" Chain 52. Turn.
2. Sc into each chain. Turn. Repeat until piece measures 7".
3. Change to 1 strand of Snowdrift. Continue rows of sc until Snowdrift stripe measures 5".
4. Change to 2 strands of Blue Agave. Continue rows of sc until Blue Agave stripe measures 6".
5. Change back to 1 strand of Snowdrift. Continue rows of sc until Snowdrift stripe measures 3".
6. Change to 1 strand of Blue Agave and 1 strand of Jordan Almond held together. Continue rows of sc until this combination stripe measures 5".
7. Change back to 1 strand of Snowdrift. Continue rows of sc until Snowdrift stripe measures 4".
8. Change back to 2 strands of Blue Agave & 1 strand of Jordan Almond held together. Continue rows of sc until this stripe measures 5".
9. Bind off. Weave all ends in.
10. On both short ends finish off each with a row of sc holding 2 strands of Blue Agave. Weave in ends.

Finished throw measures approximately 61" x 35".
