SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- TLC® Essentials™ yarn:
 - 4 skeins Taupe A
 - 1 skein each Paradise Blue B and Light Celery C
- Circular knitting needle: 6mm [US 10] – 29"
- Yarn needle

SIZE: Throw measures 51"x59".

GAUGE: 1 Chevron = 4¼" across; 12 rows = 2½" in pattern.

CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge

DIRECTIONS:

With A, cast on 204 sts. Do not join, but work back and forth in rows as follows:

Foundation Row (Wrong Side): Knit.

Row 1 (Right Side): * K2tog, K6, yo, K1, yo, K6, sl 1, K1, pssso; rep from * across – 12 chevrons.

Row 2: Knit.

Rows 3 and 4: With B, Knit.

Rows 5 and 7: With A, * K2tog, K6, yo, K1, yo, K6, sl 1, K1, pssso; rep from * across.

Rows 6 and 8: With A, Purl.

Rows 9 and 10: With C, Knit.

Rows 11-14: With A, rep Rows 5-8.

Rep Rows 3-14 twenty two more times, then rep Rows 3 and 4 with B, then Row 5 with A. K3 rows with CA. Bind off.

Weave in ends on wrong side with yarn needle.

ABBREVIATIONS:

- A, B, C = Color A, B, C
- K = knit
- ch = chain
- mm = millimeters
- P = purl
- pssso = pass the slipped stitch over the Knit stitch
- rep = repeat
- sl = slip
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- tog = together
- yo = yarn over
- * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated
