SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Adirondack chair, shown with whitewash finish
- Acrylic paints: yellow, purple, red, blue, dark pink, light pink, 3 shades of green, black
- Paintbrushes: 1/2" flat, small round, angular shader, medium width for varnish
- Paper
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Varnish

DIRECTIONS:

1. Draw and cut flowers, stems and leaves on paper. Position them on the chair to create a pleasing design. Lightly trace around the shapes with pencil.
2. Fill in the grass areas. Paint stems and leaves in green. Edge and highlight stems and leaves with complementary shades of green.
3. Refer to photo. Paint flower shapes in a solid color. Add shadows and highlights. Add black accents.
4. If the chair will be exposed to the elements, paint it with a coat of varnish.
