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SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

Legacy Studio[™] quilting fabrics:

2¼ yds Flora Spice Metallic

2¼ yds Chrysanthemums

2¼ yds Cloudy Day Metallic

2¼ yds Fanflora

2¼ yds Floral Scroll

1 yd Floral Breeze Blue

1/3 yd Floral Breeze Green

- 96"x104" Batting piece
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine

1/3 yd Fan Lace

2½ yds Spatter Texture Black

1¼ yds Marble Texture Green

1¼ yds Ribbon Wave

2½ yds Spatter Texture Black — Backing pieced with other remaining scraps. or 8¾ yds for a pieced Black Backing

CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

- Wide Vertical Rows: Cut one 10%"x72%" strip each from the length of Flora Spice Metallic, Chrysanthemums, Cloudy Day, Fanflora and Floral Scroll.
- Narrow Vertical Rows: Cut four 2½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips of each fabric Floral Breeze Blue, Floral Breeze Green and Fan Lace. Piece together the four strips from each fabric and from that cut two 2½"x72½" strips of each pattern.
- Vertical Row Sashings: Cut twenty-four 2" x WOF strips from the Splatter Texture Black. Piece the strips together to make twelve 2"x72½" strips.
- Horizontal Row Sashing: Cut ten 2" x WOF strips from the Splatter Texture Black. Piece the strips together to make four 2"x88½" strips.
- Wide Horizontal Rows: Cut five 7½" x WOF strips from the Ribbon Wave. Piece the strips together to make two 7½"x88½" strips, matching the pattern on each strip.
- Narrow Horizontal Rows: Cut ten 1½" x WOF strips from Marble Texture. Piece the strips together to make four 1½"x88½" strips.
- Flying Geese Center: Cut eighteen 4½"x8½" Floral Breeze Blue strips.
- Flying Geese Corners: Cut thirty-six 4½" Marble Texture squares.
- Binding: Cut nine 2½" x WOF strips from the Splatter Texture Black. Piece the strips together at a 45-degree
 angle to make the binding.
- Backing: Either piece the remaining fabrics from Flora Spice, Chrysanthemums, Cloudy Day, Fanflora and Floral Scroll with 2½ yards of Spatter Texture, or piece 8¾ yards of Spatter Texture into one 96"x104" for the backing.

SEWING DIRECTIONS:


- 1. Sew one 2"x72½" Spatter Texture strip to each side of one 2½"x72½" Floral Breeze Blue strip, lengthwise. Repeat with the remaining Floral Breeze Blue strip, two 2½"x72½" Floral Breeze Green strips and two 2½"x72½" Fan Lace strips to make six Narrow Vertical Rows.
- 2. Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement. Starting and ending with a Narrow Vertical row, sew together the six Narrow Vertical Rows and Five Wide Vertical Rows (listed in the cutting instructions), alternating them to make the quilt top.
- 3. To make the Flying Geese, place one 4½" Marble Texture Square on top of the left end of a 4½"x8½" Floral Breeze Blue strip, right sides together (fig. 1). Draw a diagonal line across the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 1). Sew across the drawn line.
- 4. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim the excess fabrics from the back, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (fig. 2).
- 5. Place another 4½" Marble Texture Square on the right side of the 4½"x8½" Floral Breeze strip. Draw and sew a line from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (fig. 3).
- 6. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim the excess fabrics from the back, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (fig. 4).
- 7. Repeat Steps 3-6 to make eighteen Flying Geese Units.
- 8. Refer to the photo and sew together nine Flying Geese Units end to end to make one side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew the borders to each side of the quilt top.
- 9. To make the Top Horizontal Border, sew one 1½"x88½" Marble Texture strip to the top and bottom of one 7½"x88½" Ribbon Wave strip. Sew one 2"x88½" Spatter Texture strip to the top and bottom of the Marble Texture strip. Repeat to make the Bottom Horizontal Border.
- 10. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.





