SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Cricut® items:
 - Personal Electronic Cutter
 - Cartridges: George and Basic Shapes, ZooBalloo
- Scalloped scissors
- Small circle punch
- 12"x12" Cardstock: pink, light pink, dark pink, light brown, white, green, blue
- White grosgrain ribbon
- Adhesive
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pen
- Photo of choice

DIRECTIONS:

1. Use one 12"x12" piece of light pink cardstock as base of layout. Cut one 3" strip of dark pink cardstock and adhere across lower part of layout.
2. Mat photo to a larger piece of white cardstock. Trim around white cardstock with scalloped scissors. Punch holes in scallops to create lacy look. Adhere photo to right side of layout.
3. Cut tree from green cardstock using Cricut® machine and ZooBalloo cartridge; press Shift and cut one 5/8" <tree>. Using brown cardstock, press Shift and Lower/Layer feature and cut one 5/8" <tree>. Adhere layers together and attach to left side of layout.
4. Cut birds and nest from blue cardstock using Cricut® machine and ZooBalloo cartridge; press Shift and cut one 1" <birdnest>. Using light brown cardstock, press Shift and Lower/Layer feature and cut one 1" <birdnest>. Adhere layers together and adhere to tree.
5. Cut welcome from light brown cardstock using Cricut® machine and ZooBalloo cartridge; press Silhouette feature and cut one 1 1/2" <welcome>. Adhere next to tree.
6. Using pink cardstock, Cricut® machine and George and Basic Shapes cartridge, press Shift and cut one 4" <tag>. Write journaling on tag and tie ribbon through hole. Adhere to right side of layout.
