

- Tulip® fabric-crafting supplies:
  One-Step Tie-Dye Kits™ Camo
  Surface Cover™
- White 100% cotton blouse
- Plastic wrap
- Scissors
- Washer & dryer

**DIRECTIONS:** Refer to photo.

- 1. Cover work area with Surface Cover™.
- 2. Wash shirt to remove sizing; do not use fabric softener. Place damp shirt on prepared surface & smooth with fingers.
- 3. Pinch up a section of fabric on shirt, then tightly wrap a rubber band 2" below tip. Repeat randomly on remainder of shirt.
- 4. Place shirt as flat as possible on surface with tips pointing up.
- 5. Wear gloves from dye kit. Fill all dye bottles with water to indicated line. Shake each until thoroughly mixed.
- 6. Carefully squeeze Black dye on each tip, letting dye flow down to rubber band. Squeeze a narrow ring of Brown around each banded section, then fill in remainder of shirt with Olive dye, squeezing and turning fabric when possible for best coverage.
- 7. Cover dyed shirt with plastic wrap to keep damp. Allow to set 6 to 8 hours or longer for most intense color. Rinse dyed fabric under warm running water, until water runs clear, to remove excess dye. Carefully cut off rubber bands.
  - Fill washer with large load setting of hottest water suitable for shirt fabric and a small amount of laundry soap. Wash separately & dry according to fabric instructions.
- 8. Wash shirt separately the first few times.
