

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- Antique silver butterfly pendant
- Dragonfly connector
- Puffed bug connector
- 2 antique silver filigree bee connectors
- Antique silver insect charms
- 9 antique silver small oval jump rings
- 4 antique silver medium oval jump rings
- 4" of 22-gauge silver wire
- Antique silver thin chain necklace
- 3mm- to 4mm-diameter stick or dowel
- Wire cutter
- Ruler
- Pliers

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Fold end of silver wire around stick and twist wire ends a few times.
- 2. Pass wires above & behind antique silver butterfly pendant and form a wrapped loop on other side.
- 3. Connect necklace parts with medium oval jump rings, in the following order: Puffed Bug, Filigree Bee, Butterfly Pendant, Dragonfly Pendant, Filigree Bee.
- 4. Cut 2 thin 4" lengths of chain necklace, making two 4" lengths.
- Use small oval jump rings to attach chain ends to outer central necklace insects as follows: top loop of Puffed Bug on 1 side, wing of Filigree Bee on other.
- 6. Cut remaining chain into two 1" lengths and one 1/2" " length.
- 7. Attach first 1" chain to wing of Filigree Bee with small oval jump ring. Attach Fly Charm to last chain link with small oval jump ring.
- 8. Attach set of 3 insect charms to wing of Butterfly Pendant with small oval jump rings: Small Butterfly Charm to 1" chain, Small Dragonfly Charm to second 1/2" chain & Ladybug Charm directly to wing.
