- Size 10 Thread, 600 yds white:

J\&P Coats ${ }^{\circledR}$ Royale ${ }^{\text {mw }}$ Classic or J\&P Coats ${ }^{\circledR}$ Cameo $^{\text {mw }}$

- Steel Crochet Hook: US 4 ( 1.75 mm )

SIZE:
Finished doily measures approximately 23 " in diameter.
GAUGE:
Rnds 1-5 = 41/2" across.
CHECK GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

RND 5: (Ch $4,2 \mathrm{tr}$, ch $3,3 \mathrm{rr}$ ) all in drr, ${ }^{*}$ ch 3 , scin next lp , ch $3^{* *}$, ( 3 tr , ch 3,3 rr) all in next p ; rep from * around, end at ${ }^{* *}$; join with a 5 st in top of ch- 4 - end rnd made.

RND 11: Beg rnd, ${ }^{*}$ ch 5 , tr2tog, tr in next try ch 1 , tr in next tr, tr2tog, ch 5 , tr in next 4 tr ch 4 **, tr in next 4 tr; end rnd.
RND 12: Beg rnd, * ch 5, tr2tog, tr in ch-l sp, tr2tog, ch 5 , tr in next 4 tr, ch 9 **, tr in next 4 tr; end rnd.
RND 13: Beg rnd, ${ }^{*}$ ch 4, tr3tog, ch 4 , tr in next 4 tr , ch 5,3 tr in 5 th ch of ch- 9 , ch $5^{* *}$, tr in next 4 tr , end rnd.
RND 14: Beg rnd, ${ }^{*}$ ch 3 , sc in tr3tog, ch 3 , tr in next 4 trr ch 6 , tr in next trr, 3 tr in next tr, tr in next tr, ch 6 **, tr in next 4 tr; end rnd .
RND 15: Beg rnd, * ch 4, tr in next 4 tr, ch 6, [2 tr in next tr] twice, ch 1 , tr in next tr, ch 1 , [2 tr in next tr] twice, ch $6^{* *}$, tr in next 4 tri, end rnd.
RND 16: Beg rnd, * ch 2, tr in next 4 tr , ch $5,2 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr , tr in next 2 tr , 2 tr in next tr , ch 2 , tr in next tr , ch $2,2 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr , tr in next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr , $\mathrm{ch} 5^{* *}$, tr in nex 4 tr , end rnd.

RND 21: Beg rnd, * ch 2, tr in next 4 tr, ch 3 , tr in next 2 tr , tr2tog, ch 7 , 3rrcl in next ch-l sp, [ch 4, 3rrd in next ch-l sp] 3 times, ch 7 , rr2tog, tr in next 2 tr , $\mathrm{ch} 3^{* *}$, tr in next 4 tr , end rnd.
