#### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

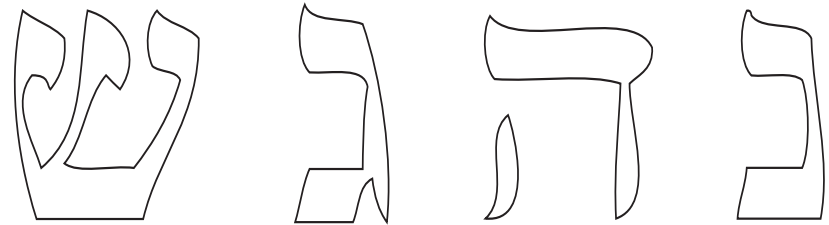
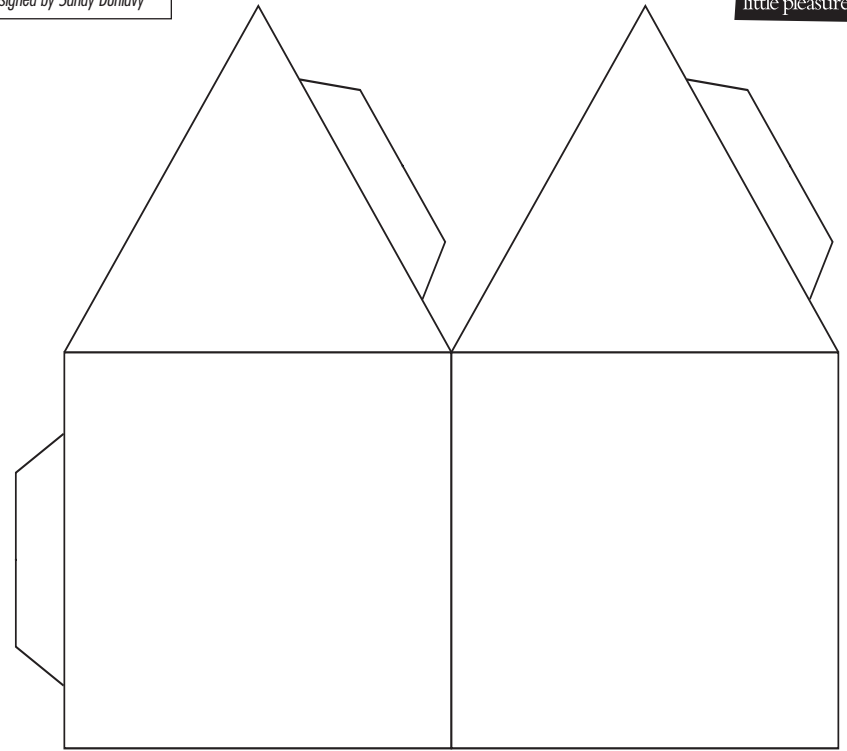
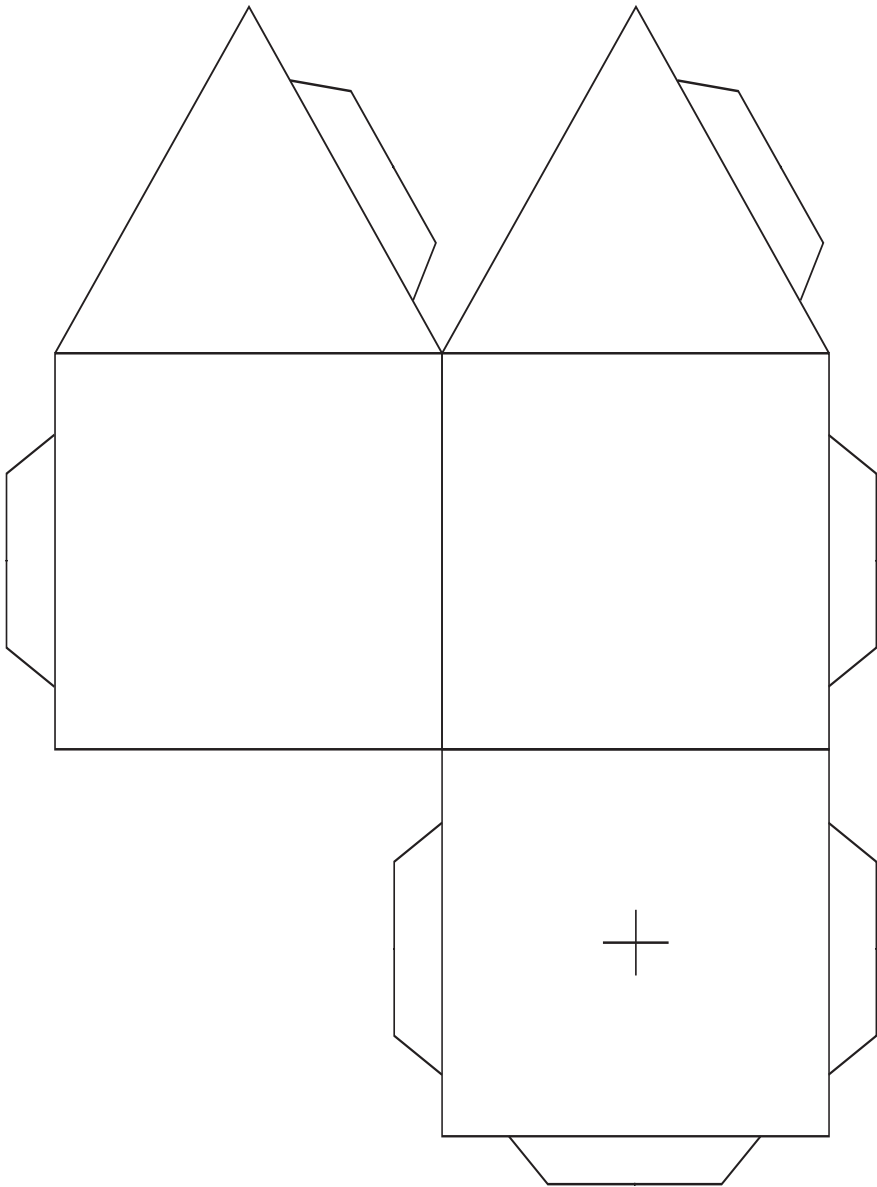
- 12"x12" scrapbook paper
- 8½"x11" self-adhesive silver glitter paper
- 1½ yds silver chain trim
- 30-gauge silver paddle wire
- Scotch® brand tape
- 2 plastic straws
- Low-melt glue gun & glue sticks
- Wire cutters
- Large crewel needle
- Paper trimmer
- Scissors
- Ruler & tape measure

#### DIRECTIONS: Refer to photo.

1. Cut out patterns and trace on back of scrapbook paper.
2. Cut out traced pattern pieces. Fold on all lines towards wrong side of paper including flaps.
3. Cut on the X in the center of the marked square.
4. Cut scrapbook paper 2½"x3" for handle. Cut 1½" piece of plastic straw. Place straw along 3" side of paper. Roll paper tightly around straw; glue along edge.
5. On one end of tube, cut 4 slits 1/2" up and evenly spaced around. Push cut edge of tube down through the X on square on right side of paper. Fold the 4 flaps down on wrong side of paper; secure each slit with glue. Follow with tape.
6. To glue each dreidel together place glue on flaps. Glue points together on both pieces. Glue pieces together to shape the dreidel.
7. Reverse, place & trace Hebrew letters on back of glitter paper; cut out. Position one on each side of dreidel. Press in place.
8. Cut one circle link from silver trim for each dreidel. Place the first circle 9" from the start of the chain trim. Space each circle and dreidel 6" apart. Place one circle below circle on chain and wire pieces together.
9. Use large crewel needle to poke a hole through handle on dreidel 1/4" down from top. Cut piece of wire folded in half; thread through the holes wiring to the bottom circle on chain. Trim excess wire.
10. Align dreidels in any order. Finished length is 36".
