SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Walnut Hollow[®] Creative Metal[™] products:
- 2 Aluminum Metal Rolls Design Sheets A 8"x10" Acrylic Mats Texture Tool Metal Tape
- Foam core board
- Aluminum foil tape
- 12" cardstock
- 3 photos
- Blue painter's tape
- Craft knife
- Metal ruler
- Pencil

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Draw three 5" squares on foam core board. Measure 1" from each edge of square; mark with pencil. Cut foam board to make frames.
- 2. Cut three 5" aluminum squares the same size as the foam core squares.
- 3. Use blue painter's tape to hold one metal square on design sheet. Rub over the metal with the texture tool to reveal image. The metal can be turned back and forth on the acrylic mat to emboss deboss the image.
- 4. Adhere embossed metal square on foam board frame with metal tape. Cut tape into pieces the same length as each edge. Affix tape to back of square, remove backing from tape; press onto the foam board frame.
- 5. Cut an X through the metal within the frame opening with craft knife. Bend metal to back side of frame; secure with tape and trim ends.
- 6. Center photo on back of frame. Adhere with metal tape. Wrap raw edges of frame with aluminum foil tape.
- 7. Cut three $4 \ensuremath{\underline{\prime}}\xspace^{-1}$ pieces of cardstock. Adhere to back of the frame.
- 8. Repeat steps 1 through 9 with the remaining Design Sheets.
