SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

 Sensations[™] Angel Hair yarn, 1 skein

• Knitting needles, size 8

• Crochet hook, size H

Yarn needle
Powersulle etitele me

• Removable stitch markers

• 2 Buttons

Finished size: Youth 3 or 4

Work in st st until piece measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ " or desired length from markers, end on ws. **Toe Shaping:**

DIRECTIONS:

Heel shapina:

Row 1: K Row 2: P

Cast on 6 sts.

Row 1: K1, ssk, k to last 3 st, k2 tog, k1 — 14 sts. Row 2: P

Repeat this dec every rs 4 more times -6 sts.

K 1 row. Mark beg and end of last row for turning point of toe. P 1 row.

Row 1: (rs) k1, m1, k to last st, m1, k1 - 8 sts. Row 2: (ws) p.

On rs, k1 m1, k to last st, m1 k1 - 8 st.

Repeat inc row every rs for four more rows — $16\ sts$. Work even in st st for $3\ inches$

Repeat rows 1 and 2 four more times -16 sts. Mark beg and end of last row.

from toe markers, ending on ws.

Sides:

K 6, join other end of ball of yarn and bind off center 4 st, knit to end.

Work both sides simultaneously, dec 1 st at each inner edge on next 2 rows - 4 st each side. Work even until sides, when folded at toe markers, reach heel markers, ending on

ws. Inc 1 st at outer edge of each side -5 sts.

Repeat again after 4 rows - 6 sts each side.

Work in st st until sides meet at center of cast-on edge, ending on ws.

K 1 row on inner side of heel so that one side is on each needle. With needle parallel and ends facing the same direction, use kitchener stitch to weave ends tog.

Finishing:

Sew upper to lower along sides.

Strap:

With rs facing, pick up and k 3 st. about 1 inch from cast off edge of toe.

K for 3½".

Buttonhole:

K2 tog, yo, k1. K 3 more rows. Bind off.

With crochet hook and with rs facing, sc around entire edge of slipper. Weave in ends. Sew on button.
