valentine fabric postcards

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Assorted Valentine fabrics
- Assorted laces and trims
- Tacky glue
- Dimensional fabric paint pink, red
- Glitter glue clear
- Cardstock pink, red, white
- Peltex[™]
- HeatnBond® Ultra
- Rotary cutter with straight & decorative blades
- Ruler
- Cutting mat
- Scissors
- Iron

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cut base fabric for both sides of the postcard, two pieces of HeatnBond[®] and one Peltex[™] about a 1/4" larger than desired size, but no larger than 6"x11".
- 2. Fuse HeatnBond[®] to base fabrics. Peel paper backing off, sandwich Peltex[™] between fused sides of fabric and press.
- 3. Apply HeatnBond $^{\scriptscriptstyle \otimes}$ to back of coordinating fabric and cardstock then cut out heart shapes. Fuse in place on postcard.
- 4. Embellish with paint and glitter glue and allow to dry.
- 5. Trim postcard edges for neat finish.
- 6. Glue on laces and trims as desired. If planning to mail postcard, check with local Post Office to be certain the trims and laces do not interfere with Postal Service equipment.

Take to the post office to be hand canceled. Additional postage required.
