Fleece Hat & Scarf



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Tools:

- Polyester thread to match
- Basic sewing supplies

Directions:

Directions for Hat:

1. Measure head circumference and subtract 1" to determine fabric width.
2. Cut a rectangle of fleece the width determined in Step 1 across the grain and 22" the length of the grain. (A)
3. Fold the fabric width in half with right sides together. Sew a seam (5/8" seam allowance) 16" long starting at one short end. (B)
4. On the unsewn end, cut a 6" slit along fold. Cut another 6" slit halfway between the existing slits. Cut more 6" slits halfway between each of the slits and repeat so there are 16 strips, like fringe at one end of the hat. (C)
5. Fold the other end 4" toward the inside of the hat to make the hatband. Sew 1/2" from the turned-in raw edge to secure the band to the hat.
6. Cut 1" x 16" strip of fleece. Tie the strip around hat at the place where the solid part of the hat ends and the "fringe" begins. This will form the hat shape. Trim tie ends to length of fringe.
7. Turn the hat band back like a cuff.

Directions for Scarf:

1. Cut across the width of the remaining fleece one 10" x 60" rectangle. From the contrasting fleece, cut another 10" x 60" rectangle.
2. With right sides together, pin and sew (5/8" seam allowance) around the fabric leaving an opening to turn.
3. Turn the scarf right side out and press with a cool iron.
4. Hand sew the opening closed.
