Kid's Poncho**

**Supplies:**  
1 yd. Fashion fabric  
Basic Sewing supplies

**Directions:**

**Rectangle Poncho:**

1. Fold fabric in half with selvages together. Measure across fold line and cut at 35". Measure from fold line and cut at 13" (17").
2. On folded edge, center a 10" cut for neck opening.
3. Finish neck opening, side edges and bottom edges with rolled-edge hem.
4. With wrong sides together, measure down each side from fold 6". Stitch a 6" line from edge for armhole. Repeat for other side.

**Triangle Poncho:**

1. Cut rectangle. Follow step 1 above.
2. Measure across bottom edge and mark center. Lightly mark a line from the folded edge to the bottom center mark on right and left sides. Cut along these lines.
3. Complete as for Rectangle Poncho.
