**Supplies:**

One 8-1/2" x 11" sheet each orange, turquoise, lime green, green, and white mulberry paper  
Cardstock: one 8-1/2" x 11" sheet each turquoise, citrus orange, red and citrus pink, plus two 8-1/2" x 11" sheets yellow  
Two 8-1/2" x 11" pieces cardboard  
Paper Shapers™ flower power punch by EK Success  
Silver beading wire  
Watercolor Brite bead multi- pack by Making Memories™  
One 2-1/2 oz. skein (each approx 57yds) Lion Brand® Lion Bouclé yarn (acrylic/mohair/nylon) in Sorbet

2 translucent yellow and 1 translucent pink pony bead  
3 opaque yellow seed beads  
Glue stick  
Cellophane tape  
Beacon™ Gem- Tac™  
Scissors  
Metal ruler or straight edge  
Pencil

**Making front and back covers:**

Cut cardboard into 2 pieces, each approx 6" x 4".

For front cover, place 1 piece of cardboard in the center of an orange sheet of mulberry paper and trace its outline. Remove cardboard and draw a second outline approx 1/2" out from original outline. Cut orange paper along second outline. Spread glue over back side of orange paper and carefully place cardboard inside its outline. Fold excess paper over to back, then smooth front side of cover to get rid of any air bubbles. Make back cover same as for front, using turquoise mulberry paper.

**Decorating front cover:**

Tear a piece of white decorative paper approx 2-1/2" x 3". Position & glue paper to front cover as pictured. For rectangle panel, cut a piece of turquoise cardstock approx 2" x 2-3/4". Cut a piece of green mulberry paper approx 2" x 1-1/2". Cut a piece of lime green mulberry paper to measure approx 2" x 1-1/4". Tear top edges of each piece of mulberry paper as pictured. To make grass, glue lime green paper approx 3/8" from bottom of turquoise panel. Layer green paper on top of lime green paper so it touches bottom of turquoise panel, as pictured. Glue green paper to turquoise panel and trim any excess paper. For flower stems, cut 2 pieces of wire approx. 1-1/2" long and one approx. 3/4" long. Thread lime green beads onto 1 long length of wire; using end of wire, punch a small hole just above grass line on turquoise panel. Hook end of wire through hole to back of panel and tape to secure. To make stem, place wire vertically on panel, then secure remaining free end of wire same as before. Repeat for 2 remaining flower stems. Using flower power punch, punch 1 flower each from citrus pink, citrus orange and red cardstock. Arrange as desired on top of beaded flower stems and glue to secure. Use Gem- Tac™ to glue 1 opaque yellow seed bead in center of each flower.

**Making accordion pages:**

Cut the two pieces of cardstock into two equal-size rectangles measuring 7" x 12" each, or to desired size. Cut 1" from the length of one piece of cardstock so that it measures 7" x 11". Measure and mark 1" in from the end of the remaining piece and make a fold to form a tab, as pictured. Fold the tabbed piece of cardstock in half. in the opposite direction of the tab fold. Fold the untabbed piece
