

**Skill level 1  
Craft Foam Wall Pocket**

**Supplies:**

- 2 pieces of craft foam (either 9" x 12" or 12" x 18")
- Foam glue
- Foam shapes
- Scissor or hole punch
- Ribbon
- Buttons

**Directions:**

1. Make wall pocket with a simple shape such as a rectangle or square, using craft foam in either the 9" x 12" size or the 12" x 18" size.
2. Make back of the pocket with a larger version of the shape and the pocket part is an angled version shorter than the backing.
3. The sides can be joined by lacing together by making slits with the end of sharp pointed scissors or using a hole punch. Embellish with buttons and foam shapes.

The wall pockets hang in groupings on the wall to hold pencils, markers, cell phones and other small things to keep handy.
