## christmas gift cones & ornaments

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Dritz® extra heavy iron-on stiffener
- Iron & ironing surface
- Fabric glue
- Large spool rayon thread
- Scissors
- Basic sewing supplies
- 16-gauge wire for handles
- Wire cutters
- Sewing machine

### BASIC DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut two 10" squares from fabric and one 10" square from stiffener. Layer and press together following manufacturer's instructions.
2. Place Christmas Gift Cone pattern on square and cut out gift cone.
3. Satin stitch outside edge of cone.

### Cone A (NOT SHOWN)

#### SUPPLIES:

- 1/4 yd cut from center of Holly Holiday Tree Skirt
- 1 tassel
- Assorted red ball buttons
- Assorted red beads
- 3/4 yd twisted cord
- Two 1/4" eyelets

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Set eyelets where indicated on large pattern.
2. Hand stitch or glue beads and buttons over berries on design and tassel to point of cone.
3. Roll cone and hand stitch closed along straight edge.
4. Thread cord through eyelets and knot to secure.

### Cone B

#### SUPPLIES:

- 1/4 yd cut from Holly Holiday Allover Plaid
- 1/8 yd contrast fabric
- 1/4 yd trim
- 1/4 yd corded piping
- Tassel
- 8 small beads
- 8 small bells
- 1/2 yd of 3/8" ribbon

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Position trim down center of cone. Stitch in place.
2. Hand stitch or glue tassel to point of cone.
3. Trace 8 scallops (Pattern B) on back of contrast fabric, do not cut. Place scallops on fabric RIGHT sides together. Stitch curved edge, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Cut out. Clip curve, turn and press. Stitch small bead and bell to each scallop. Position scallops on top edge of cone. Satin stitch over raw edges.
4. Place piping on top edge. Stitch in place, catching ribbon handle in stitching.
5. Roll cone and hand stitch closed along straight edge.

## Cone C (NOT SHOWN)

### SUPPLIES:

- 1/4 yd cut from Holly Holiday allover Red Scroll fabric
- Sixteen 1/4" diameter beads
- One 1/2" diameter bell
- Small red and green bead
- 1/8 yd contrast fabric #1
- 1/8 yd contrast fabric #2
- 1/4 yd Steam-a-Seam® fusible web

## Cone D

### SUPPLIES:

- 1/4 yd cut from Holly Holiday allover print fabric
- 1/4 yd Steam-a-Seam® fusible web
- Assorted red and green beads
- 20 gauge wire

## Ornament

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/8 yd Holiday print fabric
- Stuffing
- Bell
- 16 gauge wire
- Wire cutters
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies

Tip: Fill with Christmas candies, attach gift tags and hang from chairs as place markers.

### DIRECTIONS:

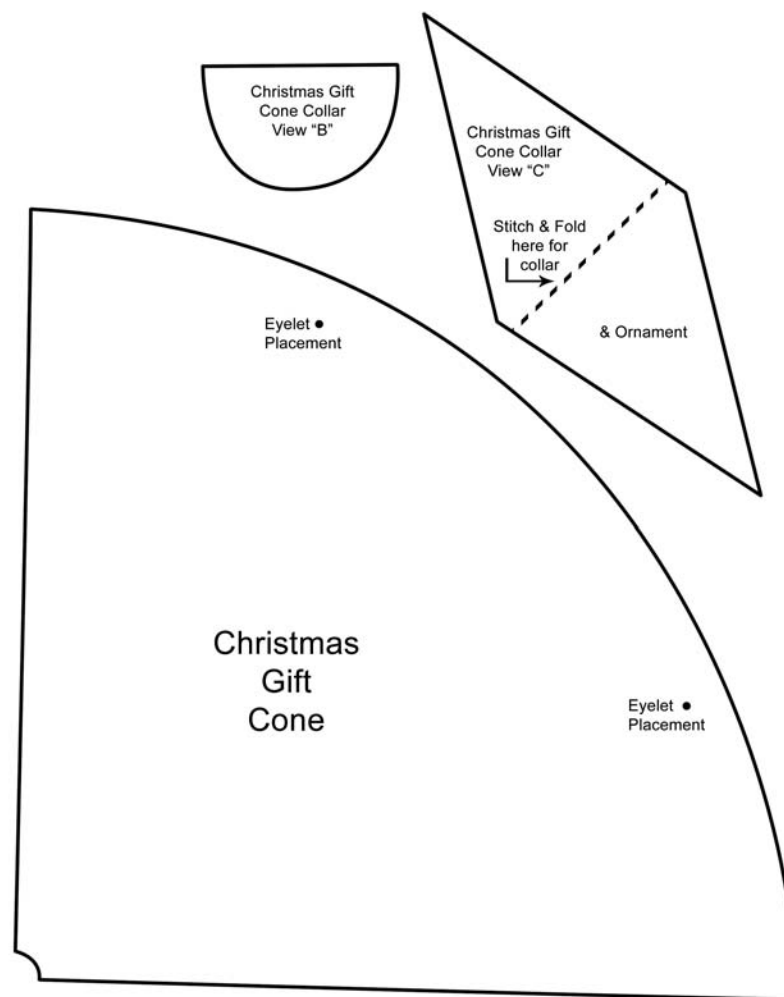
1. Divide cone into four equal sections. Satin stitch along lines.
2. Fuse contrast fabrics WRONG sides together following manufacturer's instructions. Cut out 8 diamonds for cone collars from pattern C. Stitch beads to diamond points. Gather diamonds along fold line to make collar, overlapping 1/4". Place collar on cone, aligning fold line with edge of cone, pulling up gathers lightly. Stitch in place. Fold points down. Roll cone and hand stitch closed along straight edge.
3. Attach bell and two small beads to point of cone.
4. Cut 27" piece of wire. Bend wire to form handle. Poke ends of wire through cone sides. Bend up ends of wire and curl.

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Roll cone and hand stitch closed along straight edge.
2. Fuse Steam-a-Seam® to several leaves from print, cut out and fuse to wrong side of the excess fabric and cut out along leaf design. Arrange leaves around top edge of cone. Hand stitch or glue in place with red beads.
3. Cut several varying lengths of 20 gauge wire. Bend one end of wire back. Slide on green bead. Continue curling wire into spiral. Poke wire through side of cone and secure. Stick two wires through tip of cone. Add beads and curl as desired.
4. Make handle in same manner as Cone C.

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut four diamonds from pattern C.
2. Stitch together, leaving an opening to turn.
3. Turn, finger press seams and fill with stuffing. Slip stitch opening closed. Stitch bell to point.
4. Cut 4" piece of wire. Curl one end of wire. Poke other end of wire through tip of ornament. Curl in opposite direction.



Patterns placed at 50%. Enlarge 200% before using.
