



crazy quilt wall hanging

Size: 24"x24"

The quilt is made up of four 10½" squares. Each square is completed before the blocks are stitched together.

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2/3 yd muslin
- Assorted pieces of dress fabrics: brocades, satins, crepes & tapestry-like upholstery fabric
- Embellishments: lace trims, ribbons, embroidery floss, perle cotton, buttons, beads, yarns, appliques
- 1½ yds fabric for borders, backing & binding
- 27" square of quilt batting
- Basic sewing supplies

DIRECTIONS:

1. From muslin, cut four 10½" squares.
2. Starting at center of one muslin square, pin a 5-sided patch. Place a second patch on the first with right sides together. Sew a 1/4" seam. Flip over on right side and press with a cool iron.
3. Sew patches around the block until the 10" square is covered, trimming excess fabric where necessary.
4. Repeat with remaining squares.
5. Embellish blocks as desired using embroidery stitches such as: French Knots, Lazy Daisy, Fly Stitch, Feather Stitch, Stemstitch, Herringbone, Chain Stitch, Straight Stitch with beads and Herringbone Ladder Stitch.
6. Add lace trims, ribbons, buttons, beads and appliques.
7. When the embellishment is complete, trim blocks so they are square and stitch two completed blocks together. Repeat for remaining blocks. Stitch rows together.
8. Measure across center of square and cut two border pieces that length by 2". Stitch to top and bottom of square unit.
9. Measure across center of square including added border and cut two new border pieces that length by 2". Stitch to sides of square unit.
10. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Bind.
