knit or crochet neckwarmer

**SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- Bernat® Camouflage yarn, 1 skein
- Crochet Version: Size 5.5 mm (U.S. 1 or 9) crochet hook -or- size needed to obtain gauge
- Knit Version: Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles -or- size needed to obtain gauge
- Both Versions: Elastic cord, 1 yd

**GAUGE:**

Crochet Version: 13 sc and 15 rows = 4".  
Knit Version: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in stocking st.

**DIRECTIONS:**

**CROCHET VERSION**

Ch 76. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring, taking care not to twist ch.  
1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join with sl st to first sc. 76 sc.  
2nd rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.  
3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first sc.  
Rep last 2 rnds for 14 ins, ending with a 2nd rnd. Fasten off.  
Weave elastic cord through top dc rnd.

**KNIT VERSION**

Cast on 98 sts.  
1st row: (RS). K2. \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to end of row.  
2nd row: P2. \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to end of row.  
Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing twice more.  
  
Next row: (RS). (Eyelet row). K4. \*yfwd. K2tog. K6. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. yfwd. K2tog. K4.  
Beg with a purl row, cont in stocking st (knit on RS and purl on WS) until work from beg measures 13 ins, ending with RS facing for next row.  
Work 6 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing. Cast off in rib.

Sew back seam.  
Weave elastic cord through eyelet row.
