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decorative egg swag

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#### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Styro Cutter Plus
- 1 pkg 6" Styrofoam® brand colored flat eggs
- Diamond Dust glitter
- Tacky glue
- Acrylic jewels
- 12 gauge silver aluminum wire
- Craft knife
- Small straight pins
- Toothpicks
- Grapevine swag
- Spray Paint in color to match
- Pastel ribbons, 3/4" & 3/8"
- 1 spool of ribbon, 2" wide
- 1 pkg. floral wire
- Wire cutters
- Scissors
- Low-melt glue gun & glue sticks\*
- Paint brush

\*Glue gun should only be used under adult supervision

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Spray paint the grapevine swag and let dry.

#### FILIGREE EGGS

1. Copy pattern at 100% and cut out. Pin onto the egg. Follow the package instructions for using the Styro Cutter Plus. Cut pattern on egg by pushing the blade through the egg to cut out each section of the pattern.
2. Brush the entire egg surface including the inside cut edges with the tacky glue. Pour the glitter into a bag, place the egg inside and shake the glitter onto the egg. This helps to get the glitter onto the inside edges. Allow to dry.
3. Thread the aluminum wire through the top of the filigree pattern and bend into a decorative hanger. Refer to photo. Thread the wire through the bottom of the filigree pattern and bend into a decorative design and hang acrylic jewels from the bottom. Embellish the eggs with the acrylic jewels.

#### FRAMED EGGS

1. Cut a smaller egg from the inside of egg. Refer to photo. Push and roll the edge of the smaller inside egg firmly onto the table to round the edges. Use your fingers to round the inside edge of the larger egg.
2. Brush glue onto the front and back of the large and small egg. Sprinkle with Diamond Dust. Allow to dry.
3. Glue the 3/4" ribbon inside the cut edge of the large egg. Glue the 3/8" ribbon around the edge of the small egg.
4. Glue the small egg inside the bottom of the large egg standing out slightly from the front.

#### ASSEMBLY

1. Attach the eggs through hangers, with floral wire to grapevine swag. Attach the other eggs with ribbon loops secured to the swag using the low melt glue gun.
2. Make a bow with long tails and glue to swag. Refer to photo.
3. Make wire hanger and attach to back of swag.
