SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Black medium T-Juice marker
- Jacquard® fabric paints:
 - Lumiere: pearl emerald green, pearl violet
 - Neo Opaque: gold yellow, white
- Medium round paintbrush
- Canvas tote
- Everything Mary: purse handles, large button
- Scissors
- Needle and thread

DIRECTIONS: Refer to photo.

1. Draw 5 upside-down hearts in several sizes with black T-Juice marker. Draw one side of the heart larger than the other. Refer to the photo. Draw stems and 4 leaves between the flowers.
2. Fill areas between flower and leaves with violet paint.
3. Draw half an elongated oval in the center of the heart. Draw 3 marks on the stem.
4. Paint around the elongated stem with full strength gold yellow. Do not clean the brush. While the paint is still wet, dip the brush in white and apply around the yellow painted area. Blend the 2 colors in the flower. Highlight the edges with white.
5. Do not clean the paintbrush. Dip in green and paint half the length of the stem. Do not clean the paintbrush. Dip in white paint and apply to the other half of the stem. Blend the colors together. Paint the leaves, using the same technique. Then paint yellow accents on tips of the leaves.
6. Brush yellow, white and green paint on the background; avoid the flowers. Blend the background colors together. Allow the tote to dry for 15 minutes.
7. Outline all flowers, stems and leaves with black T-Juice marker. Allow to dry.
8. Cut the straps of the tote, into 3" strips that feed through the wooden handles. Tie outside strips in a knot.
9. Attach button inside the tote. Cut a button hole on the front. Finish edges with whipstitch or blanket stitch.
