

## FLYING GEESSE BLOCK



### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)  
**Main Color (MC)** Country Blue (10106)     **2 balls or 409 yds/375 m**  
**Contrast A** Dark Grey (10044)     **2 balls or 395 yds/361 m**  
**Contrast B** Aubergine (10832)     **1 ball or 132 yds/121 m**  
**Contrast C** Dark Teal (10825)     **1 ball or 202 yds/169 m**  
**Contrast D** Smoky Green (10855)     **1 ball or 92 yds/84 m**

**Note:** Yarn amounts shown are for complete Blanket.

Three size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needles 40" [101.5 cm] long  
**or size needed to obtain gauge.** 4 stitch markers.

**Note:** Three circular needles are used for Border in Week 6.

### CLUE #1 ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

### MEASUREMENTS

Finished Blanket: Approx 60" [152.5 cm] square.

Each block = Approx 21" [53.5 cm] square.

### GAUGE

7 sts and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.



### CLUE #1

### INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** When working from chart, wind small balls of colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate points. To change colors, twist the 2 colors around each other where they meet, on WS, to avoid a hole.

With C, cast on 37 sts. See chart on page 2.

Knit row 1 of Chart, reading RS row from right to left.

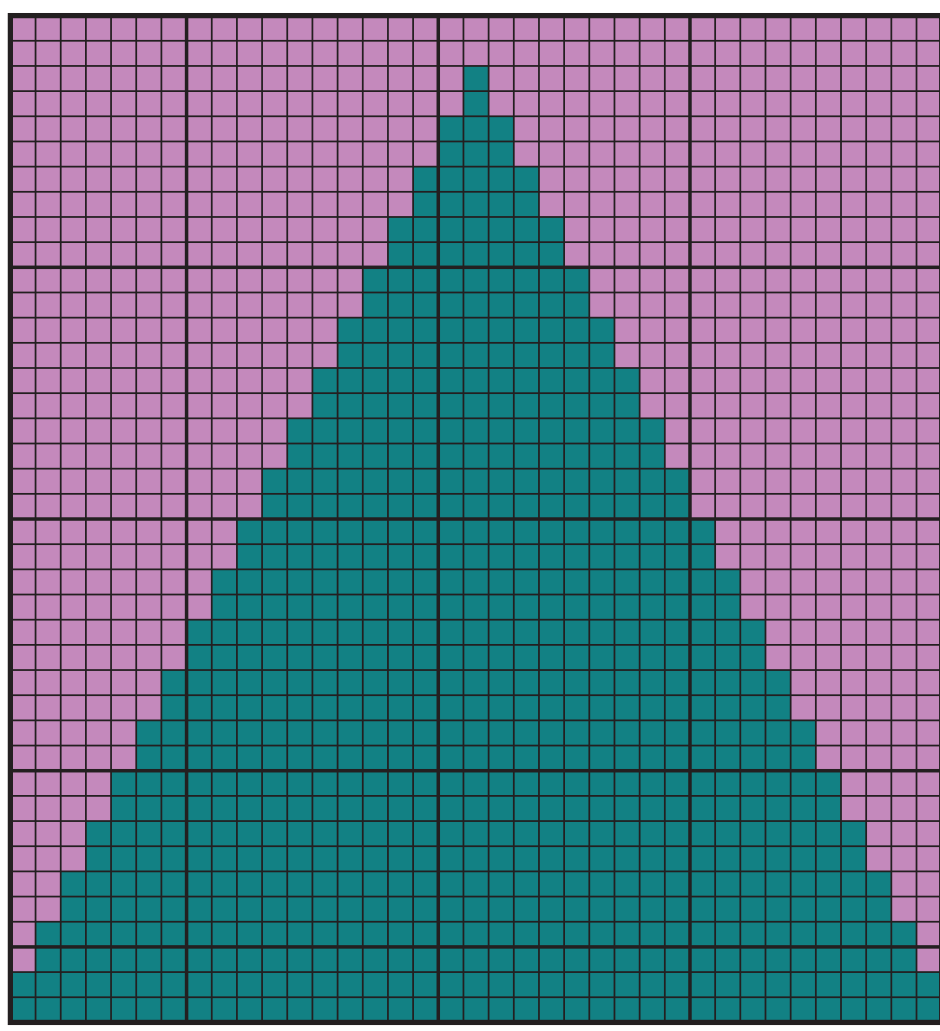
Chart is now in position.

Keeping cont of Chart, proceed in garter st (knit every row) for 39 more rows.

When 40 rows of Chart are complete, rep 40 rows of Chart once more.

Cast off.
