### USING THE MONKEY FIST GUIDE TOOL

### **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- Monkey's Fist Maker Kit
- 3/4" core: Small ball or wood bead
- 1½-2½ yds Parachute Cord

- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue

Before beginning, place small ball or wood bead to center of the tool.

### **DIRECTIONS TYING THE KNOT**

Begin by tying an overhand stopper knot in the end of the cord & hook it in the notch on the west side of the guide.



Fig. 1 Make 5 wraps clockwise.




Fig. 2 Continue around post 4. Take the working end between posts 2 & 3.




Fig. 3 Bring end UNDER & out the west side of the tool.



Fig. 4 Continue with 5 wraps.




Fig. 5 Feed working end DOWN between posts 1 & 2.




Fig. 6 Bring working end UP between posts 4 & 3.




Fig. 7 Bring working end UP between posts 4 & 3.




Fig. 9 Make final wrap with end coming out at north side.




Fig. 8 Continue with 5 wraps.

# FINISHING:

Slowly tighten the knot, keeping even tension all around. This will take some practice to do correctly. Start from the middle; work to the ends several times. Do not try to tighten completely the first time through. It is important to keep all the wraps flat.

### MONKEY FIST KEY RING

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- 6-8 ft of 550 parachute cord
- Monkey Fist Maker Kit:
  Steel split key ring
  Plastic monkey fist core
  Monkey Fist Guide tool
- Scissors
- Cyanoacrylate glue or butane lighter
- Ruler

## **DIRECTIONS:**

Follow the diagram to create a monkey fist key ring.




Fig. 13 Cut & Fuse ends.
