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# Sew with Jo-Ann

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/4 yd fabric # 1 (squares)
- 1/4 yd fabric # 2 (squares)
- 1/2 yd fabric # 3 (square borders)
- 1/2 yd fabric # 4 (square borders)
- 1/2 yd fabric # 5 (quilt border)
- 1/4 yd fabric # 6 (binding)

### DIRECTIONS:

1/4" seam used.

1. Enlarge pattern.
2. Cut five 8-1/2" squares from fabric # 1.
3. Cut four 8-1/2" squares from fabric # 2.
4. Cut 20 pattern pieces from fabric #3.
5. Cut 16 pattern pieces from fabric #4.
6. Cut four 3-1/2" x WOF for border.
7. Sew borders to squares between dots on pattern.
8. Sew borders diagonally from dots to edge.
9. Press.
10. Refer to picture and lay out squares.
11. Sew together.
12. Sew borders to sides then top and bottom.
13. Follow manufacturer's directions and fuse webbing to back of remnants for appliqués.
14. Cut out appliqués and fuse to quilt.
15. Machine appliqué. If hand appliquéing, add 1/4" to patterns before cutting.
16. Pin together quilt back, batting and quilt top.

- 1-1/4 yd quilt back
- Fabric remnants for appliqués
- Fusible webbing
- Batting
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron & pressing surface

17. Quilt as desired.

18. Cut binding 2-1/4" x WOF for binding.

19. Sew binding to sides then top and bottom.
