What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®:
1 skein Cameo 1711, 1308 Tan,
or 1502 Iced Aqua

Susan Bates® crochet hook:
6.5mm [K-10½]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm);
12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in half-
double crochet. **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge given.

color 7oz (198 g), 370 yd
(338 m), multicolor 5oz
(141 g), 230 yd (211 m) and
stripes 5 oz (141 g) 223 yds
(204 m) skeins



Crochet Hats to Give

Give the gift of warmth with these hats!
Give them extra personality with different
colors, stripes could be fun, too!

**Directions are for sizes Small and
Medium.**

To fit head circumference: 20 (22)"
[51 (56) cm]

NOTE

This project is worked top-down in the
round. The right side of the work is
always facing.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Inc (Increase): Work 2 half-double
crochet in stitch or space indicated.

**FPhdc (Front-post half double
crochet):** Work a half-double crochet
around the front of the post of the stitch
indicated.

BPhdc (Back-post half double crochet):
Work a half-double crochet around the
back of the post of the stitch indicated.

HAT Crown

Make an adjustable ring as follows:

Wrap yarn around your finger with
the yarn tail to the left and under the
working yarn. Insert hook through the
circle from front to back. Yarn over using
the working yarn and pull through loop;
ch 1, release circle around finger gently.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), 9 hdc
into adjustable ring, slip st to first hdc
to join round; tighten yarn tail to close
the ring – 10 hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2, hdc in first space (counts
as inc), inc in each space between each
hdc around; slip st to first hdc to join
round – 20 hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in space between
each st around; slip st to first hdc to join
round.

Round 4: Ch 2, hdc in first space
(counts as inc), hdc in next space, *inc
in next space, hdc in next space; repeat
from * around; slip st to first hdc to join
round – 30 hdc.

Round 5: Repeat Round 3.

Round 6: Ch 2, hdc in first space (counts
as inc), hdc in next 2 spaces, *inc in next
space, hdc in next 2 spaces; repeat from
* around; slip st to first hdc to join round
– 40 hdc.

Round 7: Repeat Round 3.

Size Small Only:

Round 8: Ch 2, hdc in first space (counts
as inc), hdc in next 7 spaces, *inc in next
space, hdc in next 7 spaces; repeat from
* around; slip st to first hdc to join round
– 45 hdc.

Round 9: Ch 2, hdc in first space (counts
as inc), hdc in each space around; slip st
to first hdc to join round – 46 hdc.

Size Medium Only:

Round 8: Ch 2, hdc in first space (counts
as inc), hdc in next 3 spaces, *inc in next
space, hdc in next 3 spaces; repeat from
* around; slip st to first hdc to join round
– 50 sts.

Round 9: Repeat Round 3.

All Sizes:

Repeat Round 3 eight (eleven) times.

Brim

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as BPhdc), FPhdc
in next st, *BPhdc in next st, FPhdc in
next st; repeat from * around; slip st to
first st to join round.

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as BPhdc), FPhdc
in next FPhdc, *BPhdc in next BPhdc,
FPhdc in next FPhdc; repeat from *
around; slip st to first st to join round.

Round 3: Repeat Round 2.
Fasten off. Break yarn, leaving a 6"
(15 cm) tail.

With yarn needle, weave in yarn ends.
Block as desired.

ch = chain; **hdc** = half double crochet;
inc = increase(s)(d)(ing); **st(s)** =
stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows
the * as indicated.
