



SCARF

Ch 15.

Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook, 4 dc in same st, ch 1, skip 2 sts, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 2 sts, dc in last st.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), turn, skip 3 dc, 5 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, 5 dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in top of ch.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 55" from beginning. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Border

With right side facing, join yarn in edge of first row along one long edge, *[sc, ch 3, sc] in each row along long edge, turn to work along short edge, work [sc, ch 3, sc] 6 times to corner; repeat from * once more, slip st to first st to join. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 1 Skein 319 Cherry Red.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 16 sc = 4" 24 rows = 4". **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.
