







































Instructions for candy block construction:

- Pair up each set of squares shown above (1 solid color or pattern with 1 white) with right sides together.
- Draw a diagonal line across the squares with a fabric pen/pencil.
- Stitch a diagonal line 1/4" to the left and right of the drawn line.
- Cut along line (creating 2 half square triangles).
- Open newly created half square triangles. Press seams toward the darker fabric (non-white).
- Pair up a set of the bright color half squares + the patterned half squares.
- With the right sides together, nest the seams.
- Repeat the earlier instructions of drawing a diagonal line across squares again, stitching 1/4" along sides, then cutting.
- Use a seam ripper to pick out the 2-3 stitches between the edge of the triangle and the seam allowance. This allows the block to sit flatter. Press open the newly created quarter square triangle.
- Trim all quarter squares down to 5" x 5". Use a square ruler and cutting mat with a 45 degree angle to line up the seams accurately.
- Stitch 2 finished quarter squares to the matching 6.5" x 5" piece shown above. Press.

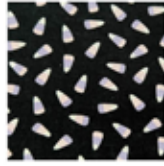

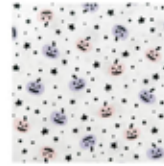

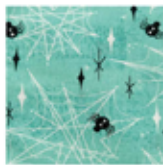

- Cut (6) - 1.75" x 15.5"



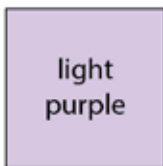
Fabric J

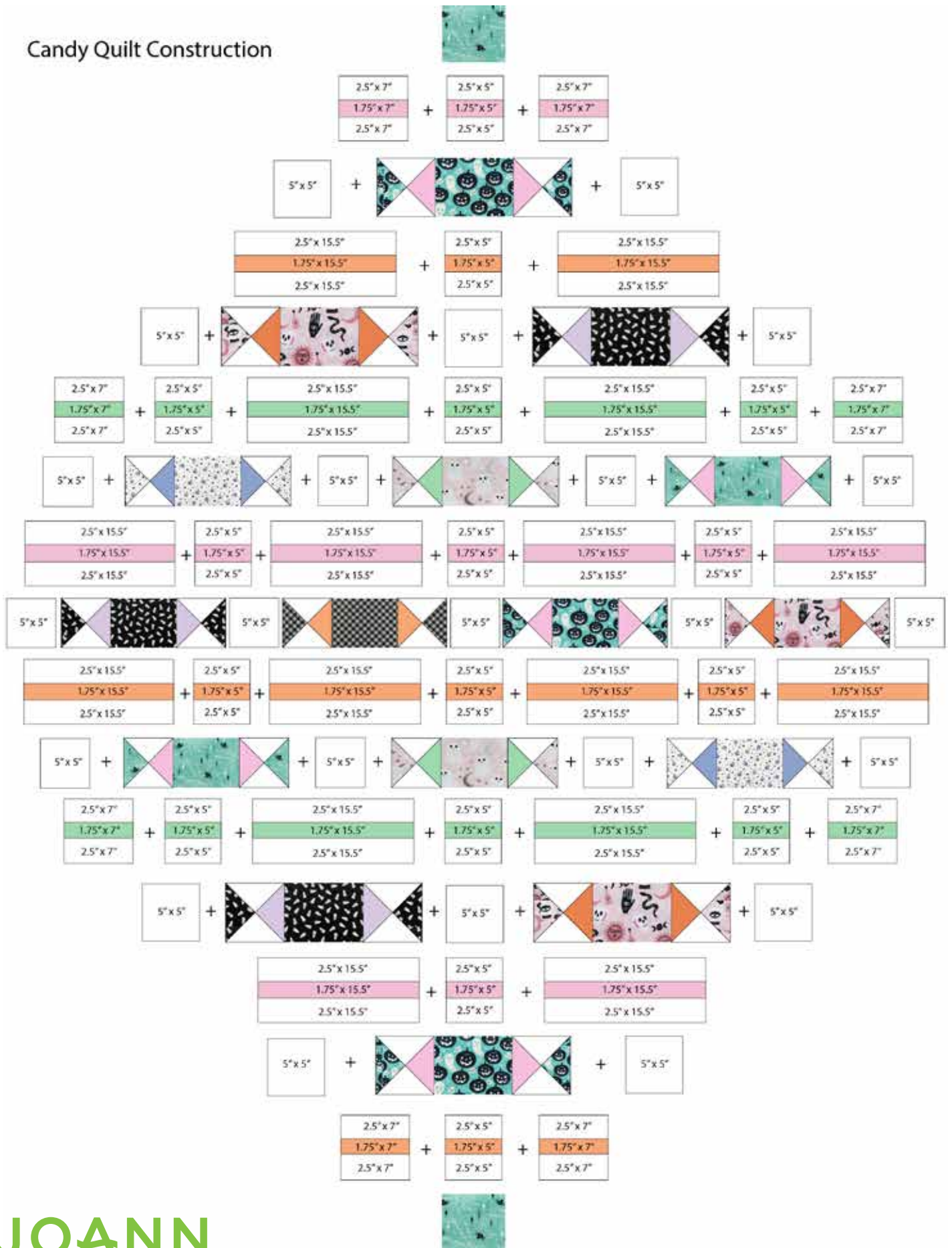


Fabric N

- Cut (20) - 6.5" x 6.5" - for triangular sides of candies
- Cut (21) - 5" x 5" - blocks between & at edges of candies
- Cut (32) - 2.5" x 5" - for small striped blocks
- Cut (16) - 2.5" x 7" - for medium/edge striped blocks
- Cut (32) - 2.5" x 15.5" - for long striped blocks

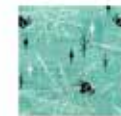
