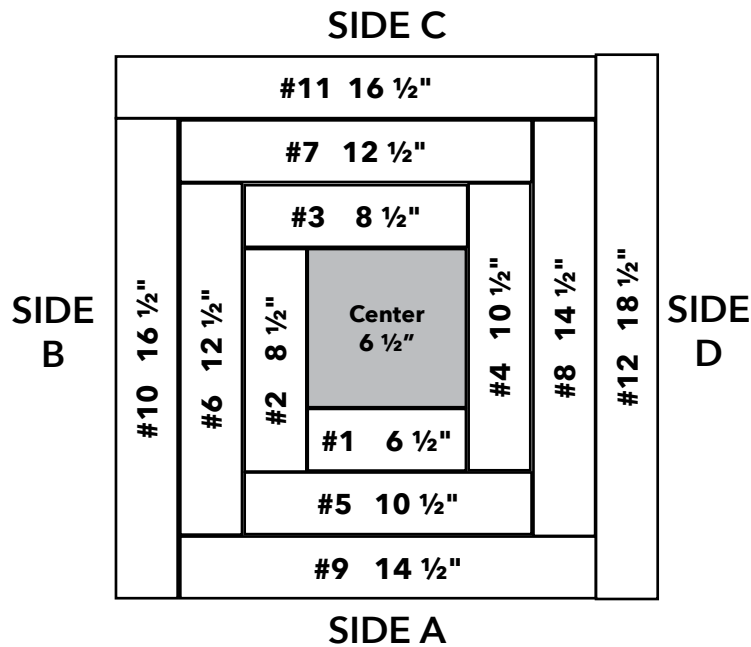


Rainbow Log Cabin Quilt



Fabric placement Key:

The bottom three strips (#'s 1, 5, 9) are side A.
 The left three strips (#'s 2, 6, 10) are side B.
 The top three strips (#'s 3, 7, 11) are side C.
 The right three strips (#'s 4, 8, 12) are side D.

Use Fabric Placement Key the drawing above for the size of the strips to gather the pieces for blocks 1 through 9.

BLOCK 1:

Center White/pink print
 Side A Magenta solid
 Side B Light pink blender
 Side C Light pink blender
 Side D Medium pink blender

BLOCK 2:

Center White/gold print
 Side A Medium pink blender
 Side B Light pink blender
 Side C Orange blender
 Side D Orange blender

BLOCK 3:

Center Magenta solid
 Side A White/pink print
 Side B Tan/beige blender
 Side C Tan/beige blender
 Side D Light green solid

BLOCK 4:

Center Orange blender
 Side A Yellow/green print
 Side B White/pink print
 Side C Medium pink blender
 Side D Medium pink blender

BLOCK 5:

Center Gold Solid
 Side A Light green print
 Side B Yellow/green print
 Side C Yellow/green print
 Side D White/gold print

BLOCK 6:

Center Dark blue/green print
 Side A Light green print
 Side B Light green print
 Side C Light green solid
 Side D Blue/green/pink print

BLOCK 7:

Center White/gold print
 Side A Tan/beige blender
 Side B Gold solid
 Side C Gold solid
 Side D Light green solid

BLOCK 8:

Center Medium blue solid
 Side A Medium green solid
 Side B Medium green solid
 Side C Blue/green/pink print
 Side D Light green print

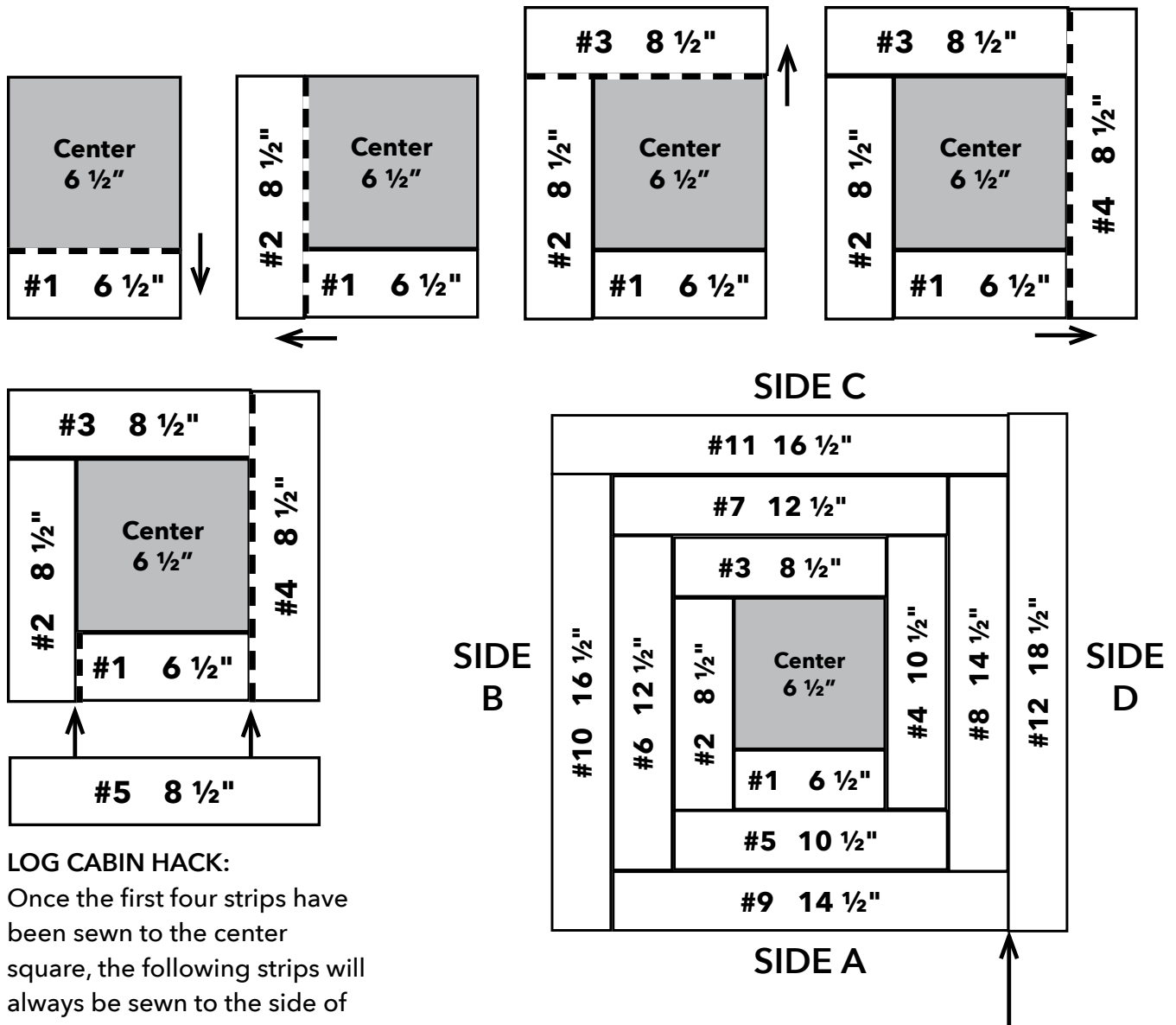
BLOCK 9:

Center Medium green solid
 Side A Dark blue/green print
 Side B Blue/green/pink print
 Side C Medium blue solid
 Side D Dark blue green print

Rainbow Log Cabin Quilt

To sew a Log Cabin block, sew strips to the center square in order as shown below, starting by sewing strip #1 to the center square, then #2 and continue adding strip #'s 3-12. Sew blocks in order as shown below. Always press the seam allowance away from the center as arrows indicate (except for the last seam on Blocks #4, 5, 6.)*

LOG CABIN HACK:

Once the first four strips have been sewn to the center square, the following strips will always be sewn to the side of the block with two seams (see where arrows are pointing in drawing above).

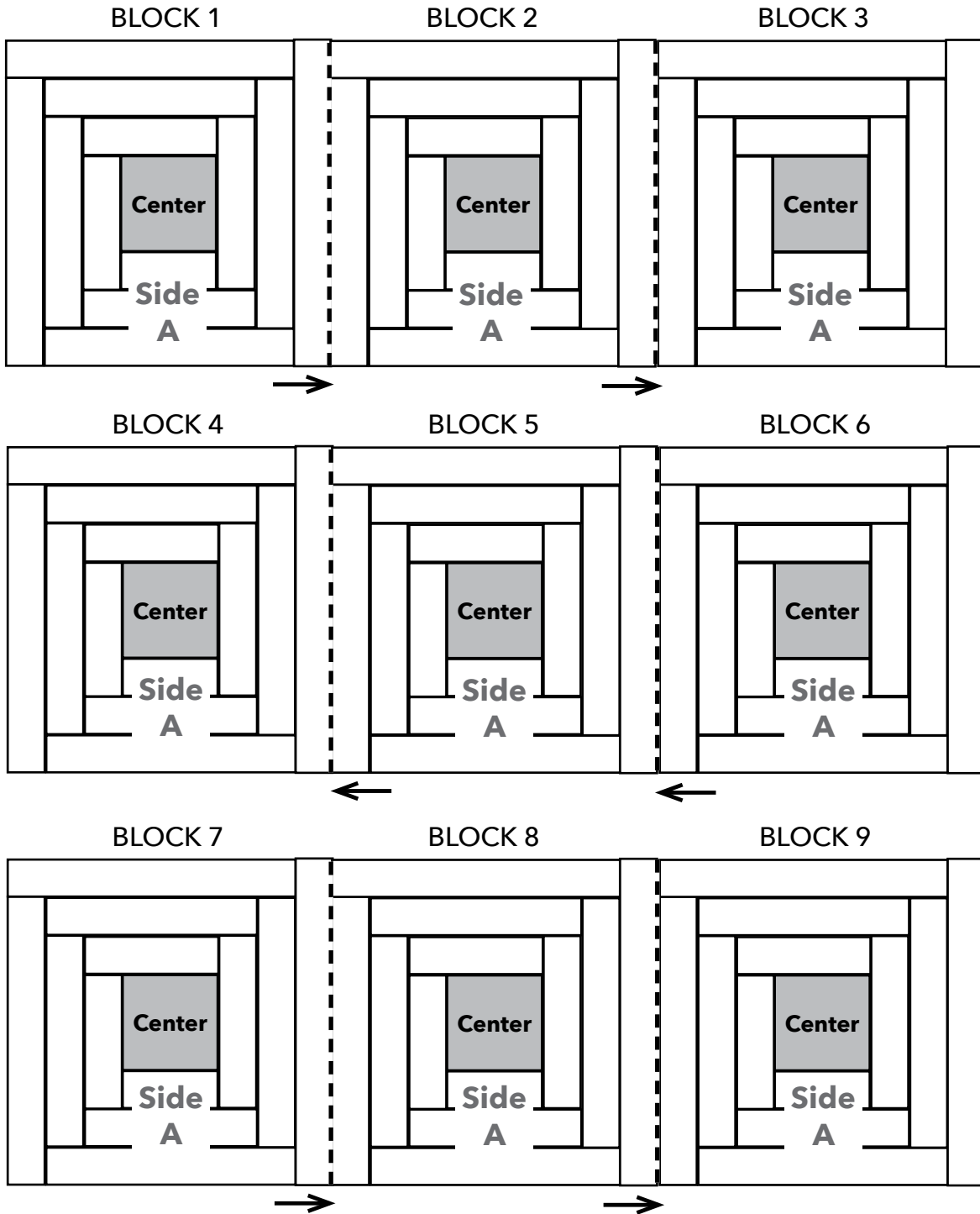
Never sew a strip to a side without an intersecting seam.

*PRESSING NOTE for Blocks #4-6 only:

Press the seam allowance of the last seam on Side D toward Strip #8 (instead of away from the center). This will help the seam allowances to nest in place when sewing the rows of blocks together.

Rainbow Log Cabin Quilt

Sew the blocks into three rows of three. Press seam allowances as shown by arrows below.
NOTE: Side A should always be in the same position for each block.



Rainbow Log Cabin Quilt

Sew the the rows together and press seam allowances toward the bottom of the quilt.
