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Sew with Jo-Ann

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/4 yd each of 6 fabrics
- 1/2 yd fabric for cording
- 1-3/4 yds. 3/16" cording
- 2 – 1-1/8" cover button
- Poli-fil
- Thread
- Sewing machine
- Pattern
- Basic sewing supplies

DIRECTIONS:

1/4" seam allowance used.

1. Enlarge pattern.
2. Cut 8 of each fabric for a total of 48 pieces from the 6 fabrics.
3. Sew 24 pieces together to form the front circle.
4. Press seams all in one direction.
5. Repeat for back.
6. Cut 1-3/4 yds of bias 1-1/2" to cover cording.
7. Sew ends of bias into a 1-3/4 yard length.
8. Using a zipper foot and 1/2" seam, sew cording to right side of pillow front edge.
9. Sew front circle to back circle RST, leaving an opening for turning.
10. Clip curve and turn right side out and stuff to desired firmness.
11. Slip stitch opening closed.
12. Cover 1-1/8" buttons with fabric; sew to front and back of pillow.
