
# Craft with Jo-Ann

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:


- 1/8 yd. of three different fabrics from the Croquet DS Quilts Collection by Fabric Traditions
- One 9"x12" sheet soft Phoomph™ for Fabric!
- One 1" or 1-1/2" swivel clasp for each keychain
- Small amount of Tacky glue
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil or fabric marking pen
- Toothpick

### DIRECTIONS:


1. Follow steps in paragraphs 2 through 11 to make a wide keychain.
2. For a 1-1/4" wide key chain, from Phoomph™ cut one 1-1/4"x11" main strip, one 1-1/4"x2-3/4" top strip, one 1-1/4"x1-1/4" square and one 1-1/4"x3-3/4" contrast band.
3. From the main fabric, cut one 1-3/4"x13-3/4" outside strip. From the lining fabric, cut one 1-1/8"x13-3/4" strip. From the contrast fabric, cut one 3-3/4"x1-3/4" strip. Center fabric motifs on the strips as you cut them.
4. Remove paper from one side of the main strip of Phoomph™ and center it sticky side down on one end of the wrong side of the outside fabric strip. Remove the paper from one side of the Phoomph™ top strip and center it sticky side down on the remaining fabric so one end butts up against the main strip.




5. Remove the remaining paper from the top of the Phoomph™. Fold the edges of the fabric over the Phoomph™ strips.




6. Apply a small bead of glue along the edges of the wrong side of the lining strip. Place the lining wrong side down centered on the inside of the Phoomph™.



7. Remove the paper from both sides of the Phoomph™ square and place it on the lining side of the main strip 2 1/8" from the end so it is centered over the place where the two Phoomph™ strips join. Feel the line where the strips join through the fabric.




8. Slip the swivel clip over the top of the main strip and fold the end so it covers one half of the square and press it in place.




9. Fold the remaining end of the main strip up to cover the remaining half of the Phoomph™ square.



10. Remove paper from one side of the contrast band of Phoomph™ and center it sticky side down the wrong side of the contrast fabric strip. Remove the remaining paper from the top of the Phoomph™. Fold the edges of the fabric over the Phoomph™ strip.



11. Center the contrast perpendicular to the front of the keychain about 3/4" from the swivel clip. Fold the ends to the back of the key chain and press them in place.



12. Follow steps in paragraphs 13 through 15 to make a narrow keychain.

13. For a 1" wide keychain, cut one 1"x12" strip, one 3"x1" strip and one 1"x1" square from Phoomph®.

14. From the main fabric, cut one 1-1/2"x12" outside strip. From the lining fabric, cut one 7/8"x12" strip. From the contrast fabric, cut one 3"x1-1/2" strip. Center fabric motifs on the strips before cutting.

15. Follow the directions for the wide key chain, omitting the directions for joining the Phoomph™ strips on the main fabric strip. Place the Phoomph™ square 2" from the top end of the lining side of the main strip in step 6.
