



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Lp st = Loop stitch (worked on WS) = Insert hook in next stitch. Wrap working yarn over top of index finger, from front to back,

to form loop. Placing tip of hook behind yarn at front of index finger, Yoh and draw up a loop onto hook. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook, dropping loop off index finger to back of work (see diagram). Loop will be formed on RS of work.

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

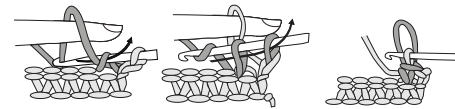
Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Main Color (MC) Aruba Sea (0505)

1 ball or 57 yds/52 m

Contrast A Black (0312)

1 ball or 10 yds/9 m

Contrast B White (0311)

1 ball or 10 yds/9 m

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Stitch marker.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" x 4" [20.5 x 10 cm], excluding ties.

GAUGE

12 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

MASK (make 2 pieces alike)

Notes:

- Mask is worked from side to side and seamed in Finishing.
- Eyes are worked separately and sewn on.

With MC, ch 8.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 9 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 11 sc.

5th to 10th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

11th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of last 9 sc. Turn. 10 sc.

12th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to last sc. Turn.

13th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of last 8 sc. Turn. 9 sc.

14th and 15th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

16th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 8 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 10 sc.

17th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. Turn.

18th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 9 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 11 sc.

19th to 24th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. Turn.

25th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 9 sc.

26th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

27th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 7 sc.

28th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

EYE

With A, ch 2.

1st rnd: (RS). 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

2nd rnd: (RS). Join B with sl st to any sc. Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. (2 dc. PM at top of last dc. 1 dc) all in next sc. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. Join with sl st to top of first ch-2. Fasten off.

Turn work so WS is facing.

Next row (Eyelashes): (WS). Join A with sl st at marker. Ch 1. 1 Lp st in same st as last sl st. 1 Lp st in each of next 7 sts. Fasten off.

EYELASH

With A, ch 9.

1st row: (WS). 1 Lp st in 2nd ch from hook. 1 Lp st in each ch to end of chain. 8 Lp sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Attaching Eye and Eyelash: Sew Eye and Eyelash, approx 1½" [4 cm] apart, to RS of one Mask piece as shown in photo.

Joining Mask Pieces: Align 2 Mask pieces with WS facing each other. With RS facing (piece with eyes attached), join MC with sl st to any st of Mask. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, work sc evenly around entire Mask. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Right-side Tie: (RS). Join A with sl st to sc approx 1" [2.5 cm] down from top edge along RS of Mask. Ch 51. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Sl st in same space as first sl st. Fasten off.

Left-side Tie: Work as for Right-side Tie along left side of Mask.
