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# Craft with Jo-Ann

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

Bernat Super Value (7 oz; 426 yds)

Main Color (MC): Grass 1 ball

Contrast A: Bright Yellow 1 ball

Contrast B: Carrot 1 ball

Contrast C: Peacock 1 ball

Contrast D: Light Damson 1 ball

Size U.S. H or 8 crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

14" square pillow form

4"x5" piece of cardboard

Sharp scissors

Thread

## DIRECTIONS:

### GAUGE

14 sts and 13 rows = 4" in pat.

### MEASUREMENT

Approx 14" square (excluding pompoms)

### Front and Back (make 2 pieces alike)

With MC, ch 50.

1st row: (RS). Draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook. Draw up a loop in next ch. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook — sc2tog over 2 ch made. Ch 1. \*Sc2tog over next 2 ch. Ch 1. Rep from \* to last ch. 1 sc in last ch. Turn. 49 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first st and next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. \*Sc2tog over next st and next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from \* to last st. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

Rep last row for pat until work from beg measures 14".

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Sew 3 sides of Pillow tog. Insert pillow form. Sew rem side closed.

**Pompoms** (make 8 each with B, C and D; make 4 with A): Wind yarn around cardboard approx 100 times.

Remove from cardboard and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape.

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Sew pompoms securely along each edge of Pillow as shown in picture in this order: A (corner), C, D, B, C, D, B.

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch(s)** = Chain(s)

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2tog** = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook
