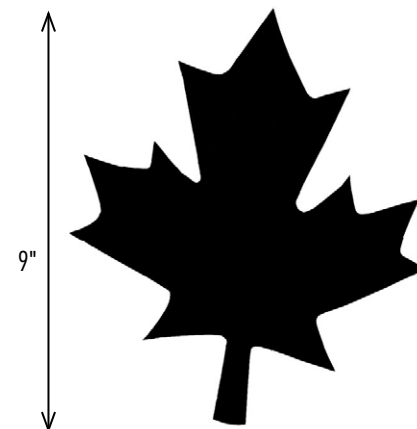

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Tulip® Soft® Fabric Paint, Crimson Red
- Tulip® Fashion Glitter™ Red
- Tulip® Fashion Glitter Bond™
- Tulip® Fabric Glitter Spray Paint™, Sparkling Star
- Scribbles® 3D Fabric Paint, Bright Red
- White messenger bag
- Painter's tape
- Paper towel
- Chalk pencil
- Paintbrushes
- Disposable plate for paint palette



DIRECTIONS:

For best results, please read all instructions before beginning project. Refer to photo for color and design placement.

1. Use chalk pencil to lightly trace maple leaf design onto bag flap.
2. Apply strips of painter's tape to mark off radiating lines around maple leaf.
3. Spray Sparkling Star glitter spray paint over tape to create a radiating halo effect around leaf design. Cover maple leaf area with paper towel to prevent overspray. Remove tape and paper towel and let dry.
4. Pour out some Crimson Red onto palette. Use paintbrush to fill in maple leaf. Let dry.
5. Accent maple leaf with Bright Red Scribbles® 3D paint. Let dry.
6. Further accent maple leaf with Tulip Fashion Glitter Bond™ and Tulip Fashion Glitter™ in Red. Let dry.
