

• DecoArt Americana® Acrylics

Snow (Titanium) White

Buttermilk

Burnt Umber

(Ebony) Black

Slate Grey

Grey Sky

Light Cinnamon

Bright Orange

Saffron Yellow

- Papier-mâché letters (Q, U, E, S, T)
- ¾" flat brush
- #3 round brush
- Paper towels
- Water container
- Palette or plastic plate
- Tracing and transfer paper
- Pencil
- Patterns

DIRECTIONS:


- 1. Use 3/4" flat brush to basecoat "Q", Bright Orange; "U", Buttermilk; "E", Snow White; "S", Grey Sky; and "T", Saffron Yellow. Let dry completely.
- 2. Enlarge patterns. Use pencil to trace and transfer patterns on letters: "Q" and "E" get stripes; "U" and "S" get cheetah print; and "T" gets giraffe print.
- 3. Use #3 round brush to fill in animal prints: "Q", Lamp Black; "U", Burnt Umber; "E", Lamp Black; "S", Slate Grey; and "T", Light Cinnamon.




