# double potholder



## SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Fabric collection: Fairytale Garden
  - Flowers - 1/8 yard
  - Twig Buds - 1/8 yard
  - Tulips and Berries - 1/8 yard
  - Side by Side - 1/8 yard
  - Hanging Lanterns - 1/4 yard
  - Carrots - 3/8 yard
- Insul-Bright thermal batting 1/2 yard
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Iron & pressing surface

## DIRECTIONS:

1. Cutting Instructions:  
Width of fabric = WOF  
Seam allowance 1/4"

### Thermal Batting:

- Cut (2) 24" x 7-1/2"
- Cut (2) 6" x 7-1/2"

### Fabric:

- Cut (1) 24" x 7-1/2" strips from the Carrots fabric = outside potholder
- Cut (1) 24" x 7-1/2" strips from the Hanging Lanterns fabric = inside potholder
- Cut (1) 2" x 12" strips from the Flowers, Tulips and Berries and Twig Buds fabrics = front pocket panel
- Cut (2) 2" x 12" strips from the Side by Side fabric = front pocket panel
- Cut (1) 7-1/2" x 12" from the Hanging Lanterns fabric = Inside pocket
- Cut (3) 1-3/4" x WOF strips from the Carrots fabric = binding



**Skill Level:** Some experience necessary

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Assemble:

1. Sew the 2" x 12" strips together and press. Sew one of the 1-3/4" x 12" strips on each side of the strip and press = front panels.



2. Sandwich the front and inside panel (7-1/2" x 12") wrong sides together between the batting. Baste stitch around the outer edges and stitch lines 1/4" apart across. Cut the panel into (2) 6" x 7-1/2" = pockets.



3. Sew binding strips together to make one long strip = 128". Fold the strip in half, press, open and fold sides into the center, press, fold in half and press = binding.
4. Cut two 7-1/2" strips from the binding and stitch these across the pocket tops.



5. Sandwich the outside and inside potholders (24" x 7-1/2") between the batting and stitch 2" in around from raw edges.
6. Place a pocket on each end of the potholder and baste in place. Cut a curve at each of the corners.



7. Place the binding around the potholder and stitch in place.



8. Cut a 5" strip from the binding, fold each end a 1/4" in and press. Sew down the open side to close. Fold the strip in half and stitch the loop in the center of the back of the potholder.

Quilted Potholder

1. Cut (2) 9" squares from the batting.
2. Cut (1) 9" square from the Hanging Lanterns fabric = back.
3. Create a 9" square from the leftover fabric = front.
4. Sandwich the front and back of the potholder between the batting, stitch around the outside edges to hold in place.
5. Quilt as desired.
6. Place the binding around the potholder and stitch in place.
7. Cut a 4" strip from the remainder of the binding, fold each end a 1/4" in and press. Sew down the open side to close. Fold the strip in half and stitch the loop on one of the corners.
