CROCHET FLOWER APPLIQUES

Skill Level: Beginner

Crafting Time: Varies



SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Big Twist® Yarn: 2 or More Colors
- U.S. Size H Hook
- Tapestry Needle

ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch = Chain

CC = Coordinating Color

MC = Main Color

PATTERN:

With Main Color:

Ch 5. Join with a slip stitch in the first ch to form a ring.

Ch 1, sc 10 into the ring, joining with a slip stitch in the first sc.

(Ch 12, skip 1 sc, slip stitch in next sc) 4 x. Ch 12, slip stitch at base of the first ch 12.

There will now be 5 ch 12 loops.

(sc 18 into next ch 12 loop, slip stitch into the

slip stitch on the row previous) 5 times.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to the tank.

With Coordinating Color:

Join yarn in any slip stitch between the 2 petal loops.

Ch 1, sc in the same spot. *Slip stitch into the back loop only of the next sc.

Continue in this fashion until the next slip stitch is reached in between the 2 petal loops. sc into the slip stitch.

Repeat from * to end, joining with a slip stitch in the first CC sc.

Fasten off.

Sew to Tank:

Using the MC, thread the long tail onto a tapestry needle.

Begin sewing to the tank, using the 10 initial scs from center of the flower as a guide.

Fasten off.
