JOANN

CHECKERED CROCHET BLANKET

Skill Level: Intermediate

Crafting Time: Varies



SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Three Skeins Big Twist® Yarn, Gray
- Three Skeins Big Twist® Yarn, Brown
- U.S. Size H Crochet Hook

MEASUREMENTS:

50" x 45"

NOTES:

You can make this blanket larger or smaller by adding more blocks to each strip of the blanket. Each "block" is about 6 1/4" x 5 1/2". Because the blanket is constructed by stitching together 8 strips, simply make more strips or add more blocks to each strip. It will be easiest to keep track of if there is an even number of blocks.

With gray yarn, Ch 21.

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc= Double Crochet

Sc = Single Crochet

CHECKERED CROCHET BLANKET PATTERN

PATTERN:

Block:

Set up row: Sc 20.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc 19 across.

Row 2: Sc 20.

Rep rows 1 & 2 for a total of 6 times.

Switch to cream yarn and repeat the block.

Work as established, switching between gray and cream for a total of 8 blocks,

beginning with gray and ending with cream.

Create a total of 8 strips.

Using a whip stitch, sew the strips together, flipping the strips to achieve the checkerboard layout. With gray or cream, depending on your preference, work a 1sc border around the entirety of the blanket, working the corners as 1 sc, ch 2, sc.
