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# Craft with Jo-Ann

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 3 skeins Patons® Cobbles™ yarn: Teal
  - Size P-15, 10mm crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
  - Scissors
- GAUGE: 5 sc and 6 rows = 4"

## DIRECTIONS:

Scarf is worked lengthwise.

Ch 4.

Row 1: 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. \*Ch 3. 1 dc in base of ch 3 just worked. Rep from \* until row measures 62". Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* across, ending with 1 sc in last ch-3 sp.

1 dc in same ch as first dc at beg of Row 1. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 3. Miss first dc. \*(1 sc. Ch 3. 1 dc) in next sc. Rep from \* across, ending with 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* across, ending with 1 sc in last ch-3 sp.

1 dc in first ch of ch 3. Turn.

Rows 5-7: Rep Row 3 & Row 4 once more, then rep Row 3 once.

Fasten off.

Finished size is 8"x62", excluding fringe.

FRINGE: Cut 16" lengths of yarn. Hold 3 strands together, knot into fringe evenly across ends of scarf.

Trim fringe evenly.

ABBREVIATIONS: ch = chain, dc = double crochet, rep = repeat, sc = single crochet, sp = space
